DAME ELLEN TERRY

ELLEN TERRY, who died in England today at the ripe old age of 89, represented a combination seldom found in one individual.

True, she was married a number of times and had a number of love affairs, they say. Whether or not that is true, there is no doubt that both for herself, her children and her friends, she often dispensed the usual conventions.

But she possessed a subtle, indefinable, native quality of purity and essential goodness, which somehow raised her far above those moral rules and regulations which Society, particularly in an Anglo-Saxon country, demands from others.

Perhaps the answer is she really cared. She loved life, she loved her art, she loved the world, not in the abstract, not casually, but from her heart.

Genuine kindness—a much rarer quality than most people suppose—she possessed at all times, and to a degree that in another would have been mere affection, but in her was raised to the higher plane of spiritual attachment.

Perhaps no life more completely than Ellen Terry's refuted Shakespeare's dictum that "good is oft interred with th' bones." Only what is good, and fine and ennobling, will be her heritage to the world.

RASKOB DECIDES ON ORGANIZATION IN EVERY STATE

NEW YORK, July 21.—The directing agencies of the democratic national campaign will be an advisory committee composed of one representative from each state in the union and an executive committee of seven, headed by himself, National committee Chairman John J. Raskob announced today.

The announcement was made after a lengthy conference between Raskob, Col. Herbert H. Lehman, national committee financial director, United States Senator Peter G. Gerry of Rhode Island, and other democratic leaders. Senator Gerry will be chairman of the advisory committee.

Raskob said that the personnel of both committees had been decided on, but that it would not be made public until all acceptances had been received.

The advisory committee will conduct a survey of the country, state by state, each member then reporting on conditions and advising a course of action. The executive committee will carry out the proposals of the advisory committee, Raskob alone having power of veto.

Raskob said that no decision had yet been reached on the proposal of Senator Joseph P. Robinson, democratic candidate for vice president, for a headquarters in the south to combat anti-Smith sentiment there.

POINT BARROW, Alaska, July 21.—First to pierce the Arctic isolation of Point Barrow for six consecutive years, the motorship Patterson was plunging through the ice to the eastward of here today. The ship picked its way through the moving ice floes off the Point Barrow anchorage Wednesday and discharged mail and fruit before continuing to remote and sparsely settled trading posts farther east.

The Patterson took advantage of the first opportunity to reach Point Barrow, the ice having started to move only the day before.

The above dispatch is the first regular news article transmitted by the newly established government radio station at Point Barrow. The radio station will keep the 14 whites and 499 natives of the settlement, the farthest north under the American flag, in constant touch with the outside world.

Before establishment of the radio station, trading vessels during the brief Arctic summer, or the tortuously slow dog team was Point Barrow's only regular means of communication with the more settled portions of the globe.

13-YEAR-OLD BOY SAVES 5 PEOPLE FROM DROWNING

ST. LOUIS, July 21.—Leon Callanan, 13-year-old school boy was a hero today after he saved five persons from drowning in a slough in the Mississippi river last night. The lives of two children were claimed by the slough, however.

Several families were enjoying an outing on the banks of the slough. It was decided to go swimming and Roy Hellman, 8, and Effie Lee Anderson, 7, wading to the center of the slough, suddenly sank from sight in 20 feet of water. Both were drowned.

Mrs. Delphie Anderson, mother of the girl, tried vainly to rescue her daughter and was herself saved by young Callanan, who changed her to shore. Leon then brought to safety Margaret and Flora Hellman, who had attempted to rescue their brother Roy. Bertha Anderson, 11, and Fay Anderson, 8, sisters of Effie, had in the meantime become involved in deep water and the youth towed them to shallow water.

All but Leon Callanan were experienced swimmers. The lad, who is skilled in the water, was said to have saved a 12-year-old boy from drowning last summer.

MANILA VOLCANO AGAIN ERUPTS AS POPULACE FLEE

MANILA, July 21.—A violent eruption of Mayon, the volcano in Albay province which recently became unusually active, today terrified the populace for miles in all directions. Business in Legaspi and smaller towns near the base of the volcanic mountain was paralyzed.

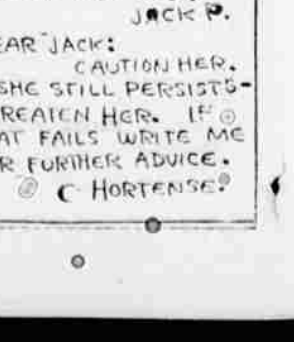
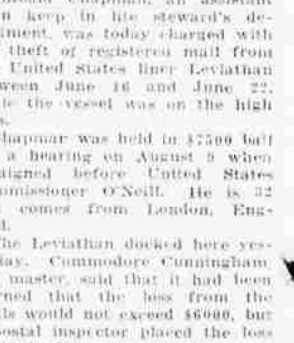
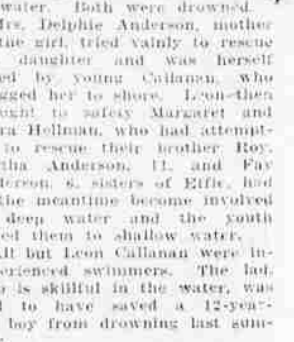
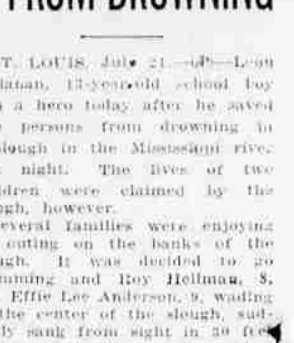
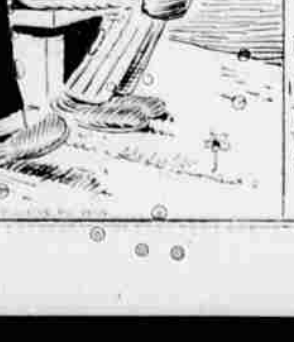
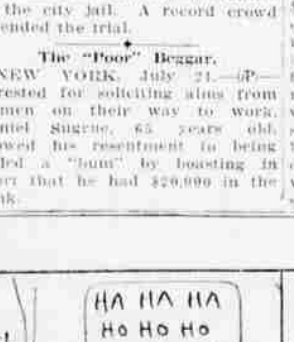
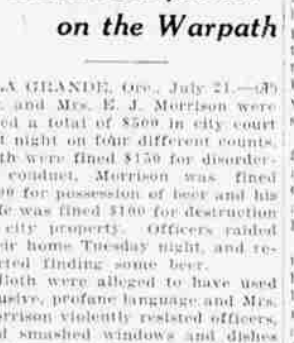
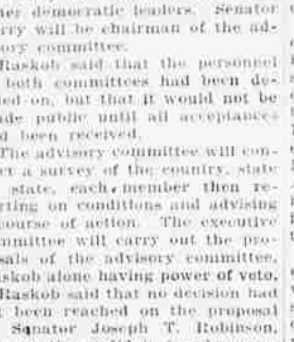
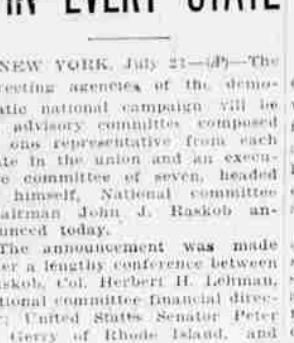
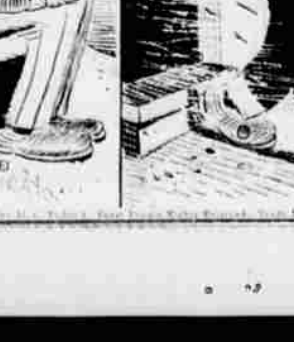
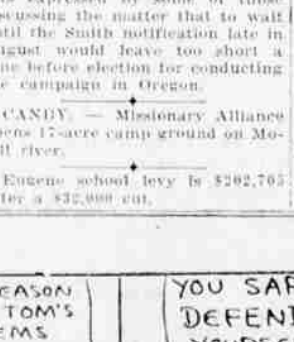
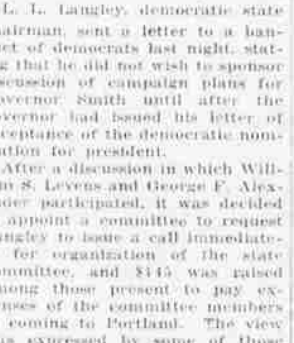
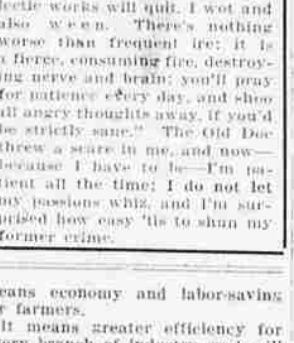
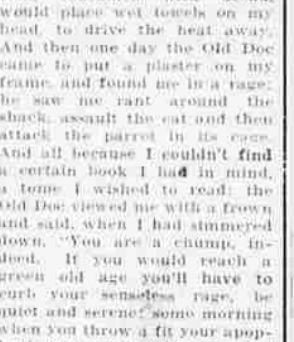
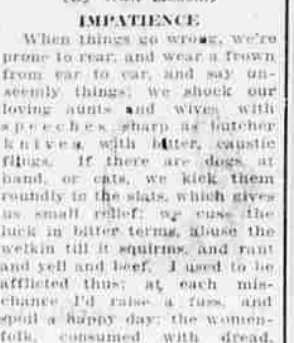
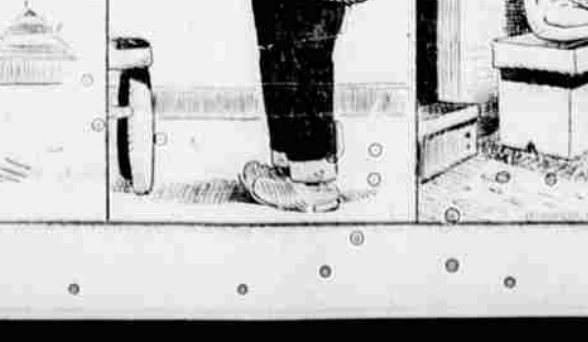
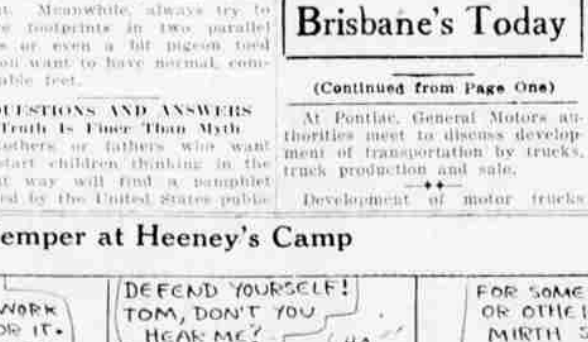
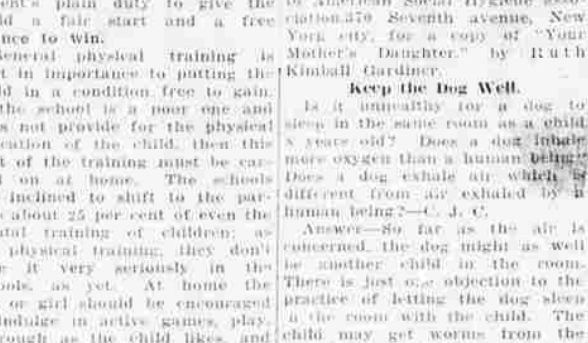
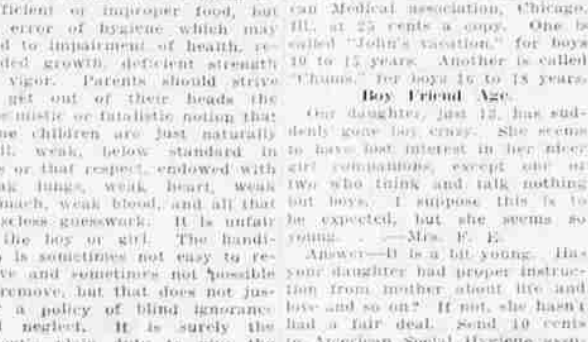
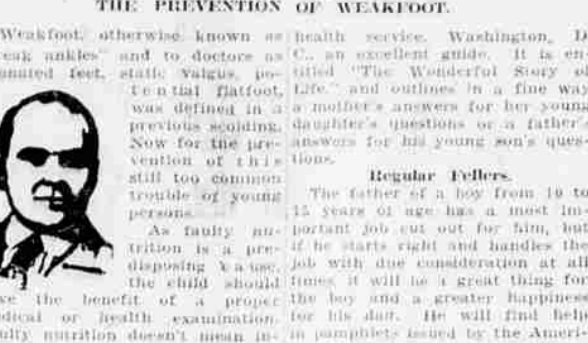
