REPUBLICANS WANT A \$4,000,000 FUND

WASHINGTON, Aug. 1.—(AP)—A republican campaign fund of \$4,000,000 was called for today by Chairman Work of the national committee. The figure was fixed at a conference of party leaders here in London. J. E. Runt, committee treasurer; Franklin W. Fort, committee secretary; and Herbert L. Gutterston, executive secretary. Active solicitation of funds will begin very soon. Nutt said. Meanwhile, many contributions are coming in from the republican till from all sections of the country, he reported. The 1924 campaign of the party has been estimated to have cost a little more than \$4,000,000.
