In order to make a deposit, the customer places his money or valuable within the bag and locks it. He then takes the bag to the bank, whatever the hour, day or night. He unlocks the deposit entrance door with a key furnished him by the bank, pulls out the deposit receiving carrier, drops his deposit bag in, and lets go of the carrier handle. Instantly and automatically this deposit carrier returns to its closed position, sending the deposit bag swiftly into the depository safe or money chest, which is located within the bank.

The customer knows his deposit is secure. He is free from worry and anxiety of keeping his money in his home or place of business.

CALIFORNIA TO GIVE HOOVER A HEARTY SEND OFF

STANFORD UNIVERSITY, Cal., Aug. 9.—(AP)—California will give its foremost citizen, Herbert Hoover, a tumultuous farewell as it sends him forth next week in quest of the presidency.

Moving southward from his home here a week from today, the republican presidential nominee will be the central figure in receptions in four cities, if he accepts the invitations which have poured in upon him. These are Santa Barbara, Pasadena, Los Angeles and Long Beach.

At the last named place the nominee will be greeted by thousands of other native born Iowans who will be gathered there for their annual picnic. Usually from 20,000 to 40,000 persons attend this function each August. Since his self-imposed silence will be lifted with the delivery of his acceptance speech here Saturday, the nominee is expected to deliver addresses at all of these places, with the principal ones in the civic center at Los Angeles, where he will be formally welcomed by city officials, and at the outing of Iowans.

Hoover had an engagement today with Senator George H. Moses of New Hampshire, chairman of the notification committee, to go over the program for the ceremonies the day after tomorrow at the university stadium.

Tomorrow he will confer with Dr. Hubert Work, chairman of the republican national committee, who will arrive here from Washington and Chicago. Other party leaders also will arrive from practically every state in the Union during Friday, and the nominee's time will be well taken up with conferences with them.

But he has left his engagement book clear for Friday night, when the 54th anniversary of his birthday will be celebrated.

The candidate will be the guest of the newspaper correspondents who accompanied him across the continent at a birthday dinner at a Palo Alto hotel and later he will join his family and a number of his relatives who are coming here to see him officially notified of his selection as the standard bearer of the U. S. R.

While Hoover will be busy during the days immediately preceding and after his notification with details of campaign work, he hopes to be able to take another motor trip into the mountains before leaving his home state. His personal preference is to visit the Taolunne meadows, in the Sierras, but it may be that he will take his party to Yosemite National park instead, as the motor trip there is not nearly so difficult as that to the meadows.

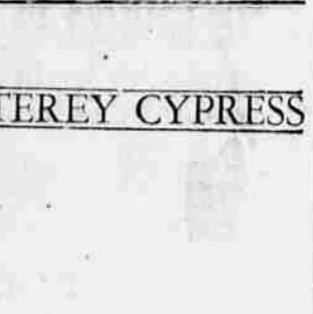
