MULTNOMAH CO.'S BUSINESS SAID TO BE IN A MESS

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 16.—(AP)—Multnomah county's business affairs are kept in such an antiquated manner that an entire revision of its bookkeeping system would be needed to place it on a businesslike basis from which an accurate and intelligent report could be had, according to Lybrand Ross Brothers & Montgomery, national accounting firm, which today filed with the county commissioners an audit of the county's business for 1927.

The report recommends that an entire new system of accounting be devised, one that would furnish the county officers as well as the public with an intelligent idea of where the taxpayers' money goes. The present system, the report declares, was brought about by haphazard procedure. It does not show the financial worth of the county, does not list the county's assets, nor is any distinction made between the expenses of administration and operation, and all department records are so badly kept that a reconstruction of the books is necessary to provide what might be termed an accurate report.

In addition to making these recommendations, the audit severely criticizes the Multnomah county road department for the manner in which the record of its expenditures is kept, and with the county superintendent, whose records, the report declares, should go before the district attorney in order that they may be properly straightened out.

MEXICAN BANDITS ARE ACTIVE AGAIN

EL PASO, Aug. 16.—(AP)—A band headed by Juan Galindo attacked Cosala in the state of Colima yesterday, looting stores and taking money from merchants. The robbers were overtaken by federal troops at Platanos and 11 killed.

EL PASO, Aug. 16.—(AP)—Mexican City dispatches to El Continental today attributed to a criminal plot the wrecking of a train yesterday between Loma and Lajas on the Mexico City-Ciudad Juarez line in which two trainmen were killed.

The plotters lifted the rails from the right of way in an apparent attempt to derail the first passenger train. However, an exploring train reached the place before the regular passenger train and was wrecked. The locomotive, two armored cars, and a platform car with soldiers turned over. The fireman and a brakeman were killed and the engineer and several soldiers seriously injured.

The rebels were pursued and several killed.

MARINES HEM IN SANDINO FORCES

PUEBLO CABEZAS, Nicaragua, Aug. 16.—(AP)—American marines are believed to have hemmed in the forces of the rebel general, Augustine Sandino, along the Coco river, near the Honduran boundary.

Airplanes are flying over the region, searching out the rebel positions and occasionally bombing them, while marines in boats and on foot make their way through the jungle hunting the insurgents.

Lieutenant Merritt A. Eason of Vermont has led a successful detachment in two victorious attacks on the rebels near Espanolita on the Coco river. The marines killed four insurgents, wounded one and captured five. There were no marine casualties.

The rebels were members of the group which on August 7 killed one marine and wounded three in a combat 40 miles from Hecay. They are believed to comprise the main body of the Sandino forces.

LOCAL BOY HONORED BY CURTIS PUBLISHERS

Tr. O'Neal, the son of Mr. and Mrs. J. R. O'Neal, 524 Crater Lake avenue, has just been notified of his selection for membership in the league of Curtis salesmen, an honor organization maintained by the Curtis Publishing company for boys who sell its publications.

Admittance to this organization depends upon regular school attendance and a record of efficient service to customers. Through this training, teachers generally report that boys gain a sense of responsibility that tends to make schooling more real to them.

Tr's friends declare he is developing a sense of self-confidence and ability to make decisions quickly. He is now looking forward to advancement to the next higher degree in the organization.

ITALIAN HERO OF ATLANTIC FLIGHT DIES OF INJURIES

RIO JANEIRO, Aug. 16.—(AP)—Major Carlo P. Del Prete, Italian airman who recently made a brilliant flight between Italy and Brazil, died at 6 o'clock this morning from injuries which he suffered in a plane crash on August 7.

Major Del Prete yesterday underwent an operation for amputation of his right leg.

Major Del Prete with Captain Arturo Ferrarin hopped off from Montecelio field, Rome, on the evening of July 3 and landed at Toronto, 50 miles north of Natal, Brazil, early on the morning of July 6. They were credited with making a non-stop flight of 4,377 miles, breaking the distance flight record of 3,999 miles set by Clarence Chamberlin and Charles A. Levine in their flight from New York to Germany.

DR. STRATON ASKS JOSEPHUS DANIELS TO SUPPORT G. O. P.

GREENWOOD LAKE, N. Y., Aug. 16.—(AP)—The Rev. Dr. John Reach Stratton has written to Senator George of Georgia and Josephus Daniels, former secretary of the navy, calling on them to repudiate the candidacy of Governor Smith.

Reading his controversy with the governor, in the course of which he refused the governor permission to answer in Calvary Baptist church, the charges he had made against him, Dr. Stratton called on them to turn their political allegiance from Governor Smith to "the moral and religious forces, which will at last sweep the south."

He enclosed in the letters the sermon to which Governor Smith took exception in which the democratic nominee was referred to as "the deadliest foe in America today of the forces of moral progress and true political wisdom."

Mr. Daniels was in Albany for a political conference with the governor yesterday and Senator George is to be there today.

HOOVER MOVIES TO BE SHOWN IN 30 TOWNS A DAY

WASHINGTON, Aug. 16.—(AP)—Plans for showing Hoover campaign motion pictures in 30 towns a day from late this month until the election were announced today by the republican national committee.

Two motor buses equipped with projection machines and screens in addition to loud-speaking apparatus are being brought here from Greensboro, N. C., for inspection by committee officials this week.

One will be sent to West Branch, Ia., for the home-coming ceremonies when Hoover visits there August 21. The other will be sent to Providence, R. I., August 23, for the speech of Senator Curtis, his first after his acceptance address.

From these towns the buses will be sent on widespread itineraries under the direction of the speakers' bureau, of which Representative Newton of Minnesota is head in Chicago, and Representative Tilson of Connecticut is head in New York. Each bus, which will have a speakers' platform, is expected to visit 15 towns daily and will be manned by three or four men.
