

SEN. MOSES CREDITS M'NARY AS CAUSE OF FARMER SUPPORT

SEATTLE, Wash., Aug. 15.—(AP) Senator George H. Moses of New Hampshire, eastern field marshal for Hoover forces, reiterated his confidence in a republican victory at the coming election, before boarding a train for the east here today.

"The west is happier; the east is a battleground," Moses said. "The middle west is sure. The farm revolt is a dud. Senator McNary of Oregon knocked the proposition under it when he came out so unopposed for Hoover."

"The west is all right—everything was done of the Hudson. It has to be looked after, that's all." The senator explained he was journeying east for the opening of the New York up-state campaign Wednesday.

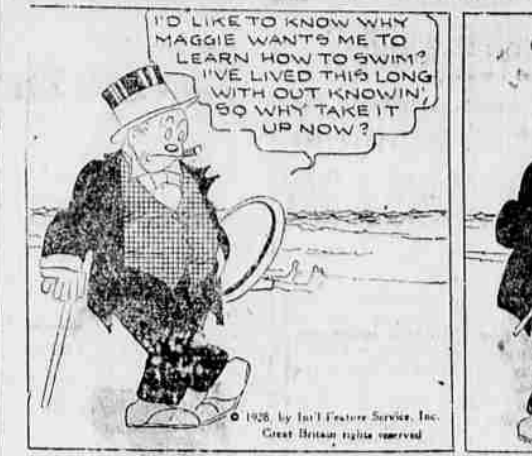

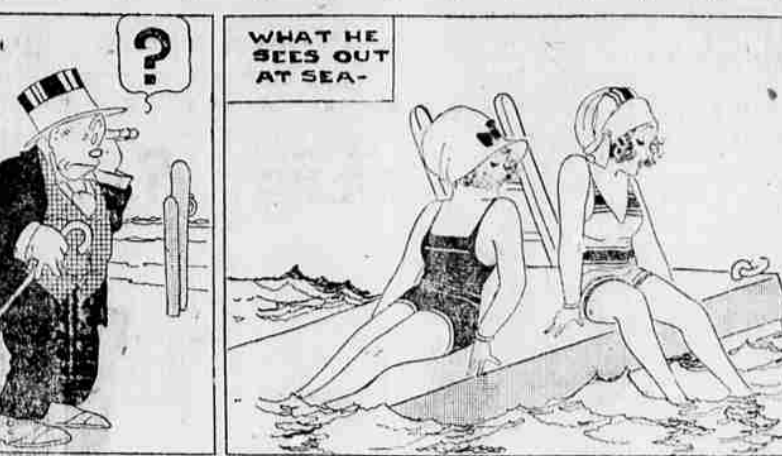

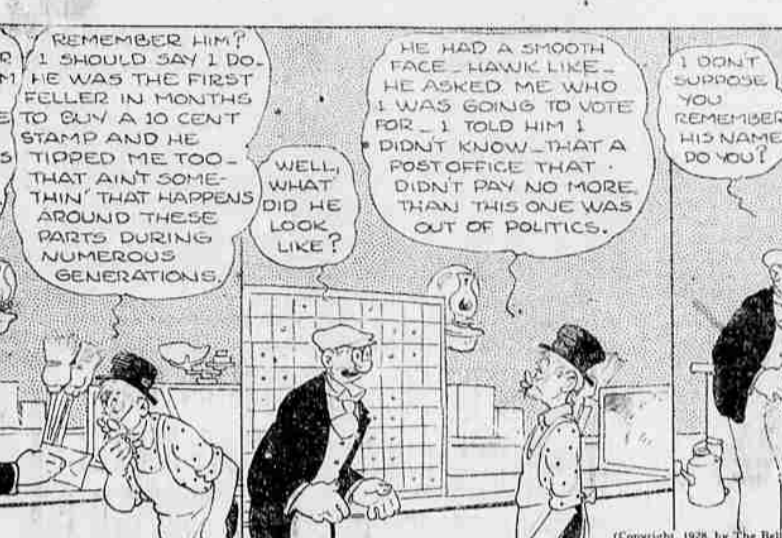
