

# HOOVER TO EAT BREAKFAST IN HIS BIRTHPLACE

WEST BRANCH, Iowa, Aug. 17. (AP)—From a humble white frame cottage, inconspicuous and far from the spotlight of fame, Herbert Hoover's birthplace, almost overnight has become magnetized with an interest for travelers.

More than 5,000 visitors from 42 states and five foreign countries have inscribed their names this summer on a register in the old Hoover homestead.

James A. Smith and Lewis K. Smith of Hancock, Hurma, hold the long-distance record among visitors to the republican nominee's childhood home. Second are Zung Chung Mo of Shanghai, and Phi Chek Lin of Canton, China.

When West Branch's most famous son arrives next Tuesday, he will find the village in its "Sunday best" to greet him. Mr. Hoover will eat breakfast in the cottage where he was born.

# Wall Street Report

**NEW YORK, Aug. 17.**—(AP)—Resumption of the upward price movement in today's stock market lifted nearly a score of issues to new high records but the recovery was checked by an advance in bond money rates. Early gains of 1 to 5 points were substantially reduced, many of them being cut in half in the midday selling movement. Trading, which had been extremely active in the rally, turned dull on the decline.

All money renewed at 5 per cent, advanced 10 to 15 cents to 6 1/2 as banks called \$40,000,000 in loans.

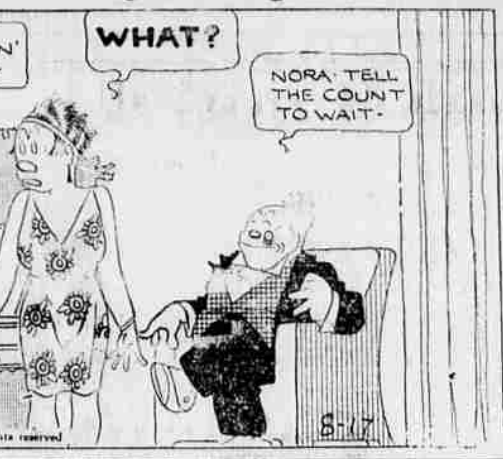
The closing was heavy. Prices sold off steadily when the market was obliged to take a large amount of stock as early buyers revised their opinions of the credit situation on a further rise in call money to 7 per cent. Scarcely any trace remained of the pronounced freedom advance. Particular weakness of Radio and large offerings of Chrysler had a damaging effect on sentiment. An exception was the rise of International nickel to 103 1/2, a new top, on the increase in the annual dividend to \$3 a share. Total sales approximated 2,850,000 shares.

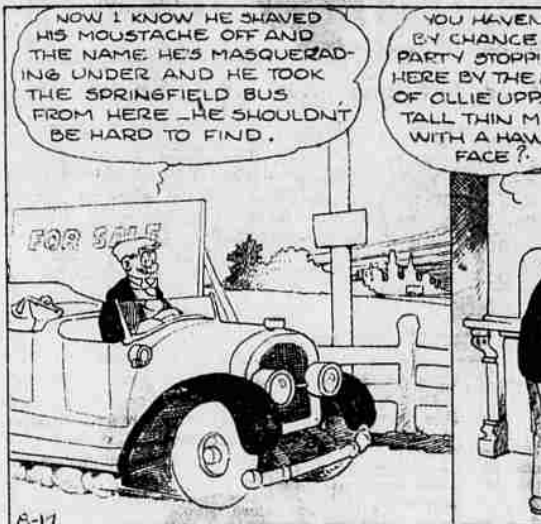

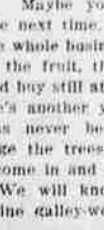
