Wall Street Report NEW YORK, Aug. 24.—(AP) Speculation for the advance such as characterized the big three million and four million share markets last spring broke out on the New York stock exchange. Buying orders were poured into the market in such gigantic volume from all sections of the country that prices were whirled upward two to four to eight shares. Nearly two score issues, including American Smelting, National Cash Register, Chrysler, Montgomery Ward, Allied Chemical and Armour, etc., reached new high prices for the year or longer. Blocks of 5000 to 10,000 shares were quite common. Profit-taking sales which ordinarily are heavy in the closing days of the week were well absorbed and early afternoon prices in many cases were above the high marks of the previous week. Stocks plentifully supplied with funds despite the recent stringency in money rates, and numerous blocks of stocks were "shorted" to cover in many issues. The closing was strong. Some oils joined in a late spurt caused by short covering over the week end, which lifted numerous issues 2 to 4 points. Anthony Reising, Houston, Tex., International, etc., Hovers and American Radiator were in the van of the final upturn. Some of the earlier pace-makers added several points to their previous gains. Notably Montgomery Ward, which extended its advance to 15 points. Total sales approximated 3,700,000. Elkins—Grain yields are reported well above early estimates. More—Wheat warehouses filled, with crop only partially harvested.

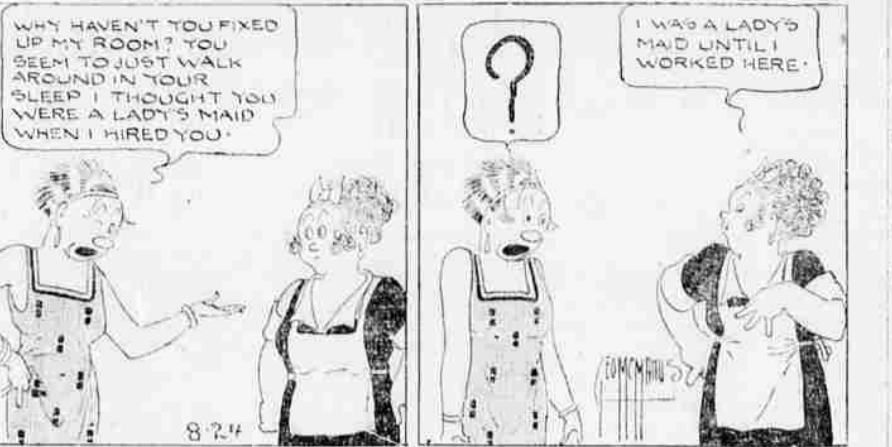
