

HARD TIMES WITH SMITH FORCASTED

Lammot du Pont Will Vote for Hoover—Fears Business Depression More Than Odious Evils of Prohibition, Which He Hopes to See Controlled On Sensible Lines.

WILMINGTON, Del., Aug. 28.—(AP)—Within a few weeks after his brother, Pierre du Pont, announced that he would support Governor Smith for the presidency, Lammot du Pont announced in a statement made public today that he would vote for Herbert Hoover.

Lammot du Pont is president of E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Co., and his brother, who held that office during the world war, is chairman of the board. They are cousins of Coleman du Pont, republican United States senator from Delaware.

Lammot du Pont's statement appears to business men to stand by the republican party "because under republican government for the last eight years we have had prosperity and under democratic administration we have had less prosperity, and usually hard times."

He differs with Hoover on the liquor issue, but declares the prohibition question is by no means the paramount one of the campaign, nor that other questions, out of deference to it, should be left to settle themselves.

"Both platforms are silent as to repeal or modification of the 18th amendment and prohibition laws," continues the statement. "We know that at the democratic convention, there was a violent fight over a wet plank and the drys went out. Both parties stand for enforcement of the existing law."

"There is not much satisfaction in the consideration of Governor Smith's program of local option as a solution of the prohibition problem. One of the most obvious evils of prohibition is smuggling and bootlegging, with the attendant disrespect for the prohibition and other laws."

"It is my opinion that Mr. Hoover by his stand against repeal, cannot stop the growth of opinion against prohibition, nor can Governor Smith, by recommending modification, carry sufficient votes to repeal the 18th amendment."

"A definite plan for control of the liquor traffic must be worked out and sold to the public. In that way only can we secure the necessary heavy majority to repeal the 18th amendment. This will be accomplished more rapidly under republican prosperity than democratic depression."
