

BUTTER PRICES CENT HIGHER ON PORTLAND MART

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 29.—(AP)—All grades of butter were higher on local wholesale markets today reflecting a continued large demand and light receipts. All grades were quoted a full cent higher except extra which advanced half a cent. Butterfat buying prices were also quoted a cent higher on the basis of 52 cents delivered in Portland. Print butter advanced a cent to 51 cents in sympathy with the rise in standard cubes. Egg values were steady at yesterday's advances and receipts lighter than demand.

Country dressed meats were generally steady to firm with receipts of immediate demand. Prices were not notably higher, however. There was little change in quotations on wholesale fruit and vegetable markets and trading was rather quiet.

Peaches were in generous supply and brought 65¢ to 75¢ per box for Elbertas, Crawfords and Muirs, while J. H. Hales went mostly at \$1.25 to \$1.35 per box. Apples were also in more plentiful supply and showed a wide range of price and quality. Best Red Gravensteins from the Hood River district went at \$2.50 to \$2.75 per box while other varieties ranged downward to \$1.00 to \$1.50 for faced and filled offerings.

Onion prices were unchanged, what few Walla Walla globes there were being quoted at \$2.00 to \$2.25 hundredweight. Some Oregon yellow danvers were also obtainable at about the same figures.

Harvest of the Lake Labish onion crop has started in a small way, buyers report, and car loading is beginning to get under way. Growers are receiving \$1.50 and sacks, reports say. It will be another week before yellow danvers start moving in any quantity, commission men declare.

Wall Street Report

NEW YORK, Aug. 29.—(AP)—Bullish activities on the stock exchange were again taken up in earnest today and by noon more than a score of issues had been boosted \$3 to \$7 to new high prices. The ticker was unable to keep up with the volume of trading and fell some 20 to 30 minutes behind the market. While there was no easing in the high credit rates, public participation became more general.

NEW YORK, Aug. 29.—(AP)—The stock market went on another "bull" rampage today under the leadership of Radio Corporation common, which soared nearly \$12 a share to \$291. Nearly two score individual issues rallied \$1 to \$3 a share to new high records, with the average of 29 leading industrial issues, compiled by the Associated Press, setting a new high record for all time.

The mysterious inflow of funds into the call loan market in which the expected "money pinch" failed to develop was the chief factor in the day's advance, although favorable trade and earnings reports also played a part. Rumors of merger and dividend rumors were circulated around Wall Street and over the brokerage wires to all sections of the country as buying orders poured into the market in tremendous volume.

The ticker fell hopelessly behind the market, despite the use of the abbreviated quotation system, and early afternoon indications pointed to a four million share session. Standing room was at a premium. In most of the big commission and wire houses, and visitors again flocked to the balconies of the stock exchange to witness the greatest "bull" market since last spring.

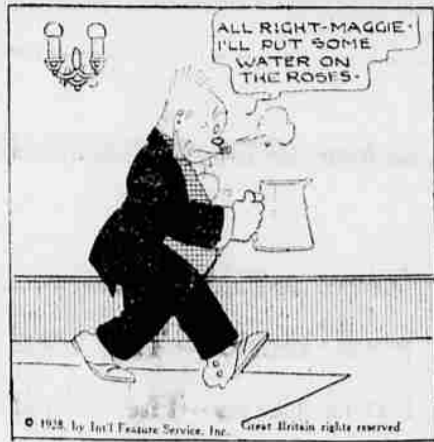
