

BALLOON BATTLES SUDDEN GALE AND THEN LANDS SAFE

DETROIT, Sept. 12.—(AP) The little semi-rigid balloon, Puritan, a Zeppelin type craft, owned by the Goodyear Tire and Rubber company of Akron, Ohio, held a thrilling victory today over one of her traditional enemies, the lower-latitude gale.

The first gusts caused the Puritan to pitch violently. Pilots A. J. Bostetter and Vernon Smith headed the craft into the wind and the perilous battle that was to last for 35 minutes was on.

HOOVER FRANKLY REFUSES PLEDGE WOMEN REQUEST

WASHINGTON, Sept. 12.—(AP) —Herbert Hoover today frankly told a delegation from the Woman's party that he would not pledge himself to an equal rights amendment to the constitution until he had completed an exhaustive study of the effect of such a change in the fundamental law.

The Republican candidate said he was now having an investigation made and would carefully consider the results. He added that he wanted to be honest with the delegation and that he did not know of anything more serious than for a candidate for office or a public official to pledge himself to work for a change in the constitution.
