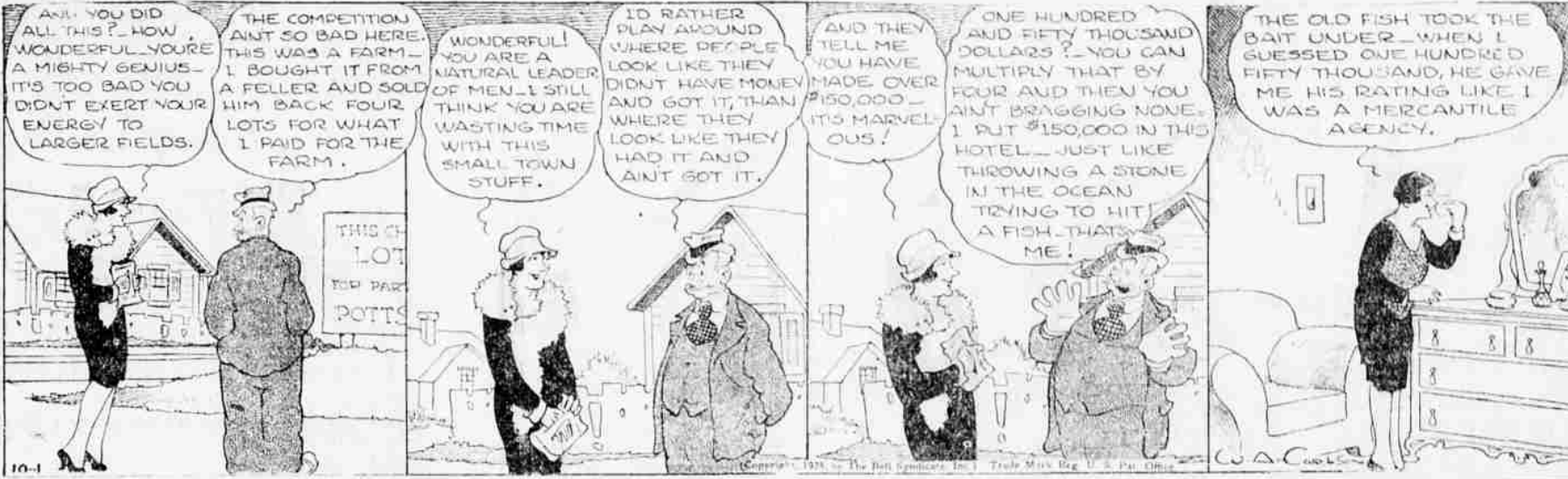

NEW YORK, Oct. 1.—(AP)—High call money rates, the outgrowth of unusually heavy quarterly disbursements, had a restraining effect on trading in today's stock market, which displayed an irregular price trend. Fin. Cos. of selling sweet through the market, at intervals, causing sharp recessions in some of the recent favorites. The bull forces were not altogether intimidated by the 10 per cent call money rate, the highest in several months. Chrysler was pushed up 1 1/2 points to 12 1/2, a record price. Brockway Motor made a new ton, missing 77. Parity Packing, Jewel Ton, Otis Elevator and National Dairy Products also moved up fast. In the meantime, effective selling pressure was directed against many popular shares, including Radio and General Motors. Total sales approximated 2,600,000 shares.
