(Continued from Page One.) here, but they are mild compared with those of Asia. Those Mohammedans of western China killed off, at one time, enough Chinese to build all the canals and roads needed in the United States.

Mohammedans constitute only one-third of the population in Kansas province, but they are savage fighters. Other Mohammedans, Africans, living in India under British rule, are also good fighters.

The original Bonaparte, of humble French parentage, worked his way up in Napoleon's army, and Bonaparte made the king of Sweden. Now one of his descendants will make a fine young American girl part of Sweden's well behaved royalty.

Russia, with territory, resources and future possibilities unlimited, is struggling to change some of her possibilities into real money, and wisely concentrates on her magnificent oil fields.

In the next 12 months Russia will have 12,000,000 tons of oil for sale. A new pipe line will enable her to put gasoline on tank ships at 8 cents a gallon.

That may create interesting competition across the water. But do not sell your oil stocks if they are the right kind, having back of them oil in the ground, not promises in the air.

This poll is now at the half-way mark. It is four weeks old, and has four more weeks to go. Hoover's total is now 1,201,869, Smith's total 688,829.

An examination of the tabulation shows that Smith's gain this week has been due entirely to votes from New York City and the Solid South, in other words, from districts where Smith's superior strength is, and always has been, conceded.

Nothing short of a miracle can now change this situation materially as far as the Digest poll is concerned. For returns from the eight missing states, in all likelihood, will increase rather than decrease Hoover's advantage.

These states are: Delaware, Florida, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Mississippi, South Dakota, North Dakota.

Delaware, Kansas and Iowa are certainly for Hoover. Mississippi only is equally certain for Smith. This would add 26 electoral votes to the Hoover column and 10 to the Smith column.

Giving all the other states to Smith except Minnesota—where it is conceded even by Mr. Raskob, the Republicans have a slight advantage—and Mr. Hoover would have 38 electoral votes and Smith 26.

The best evidence that the Digest poll is fairly accurate can be found in other nation-wide polls. All of them point to an overwhelming Hoover victory, but with less one-sided majorities.

In the Hearst poll, for example, Smith is leading in only one Northern state, New York; and in one border state, Missouri. All the rest of his strength is from the Solid South. The vote in the electoral college, based on this poll, stands: Hoover, 398; Smith, 133.

In the popular vote, however, with approximately a million tabulated, Hoover is leading Smith by only 100,000.

If we were to predict regarding November 6th, we would be inclined to place our prophecy midway between Literary Digest and Hearst polls. That is, we would be surprised if Hoover should win in the electoral college by such an overwhelming majority as 398 to 133, and we would be even more surprised if the popular vote for Hoover should approximate the present Digest percentage of 63, to only 36 for Smith.

We would shoot about midway between. But we would certainly maintain that as the political situation stands NOW—Smith is unquestionably beaten.

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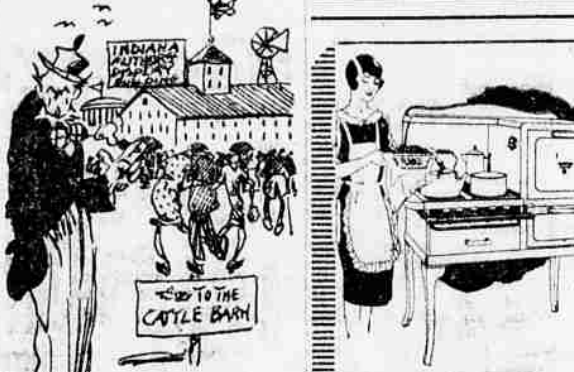

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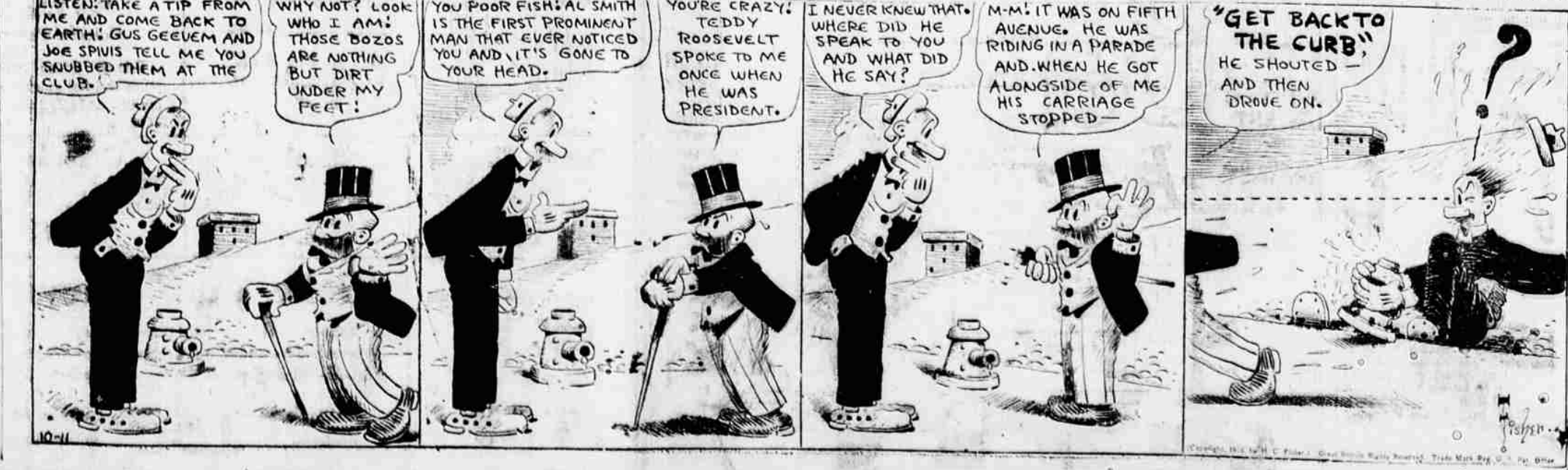
