

SENATOR ROBINSON SEATTLE TONIGHT, PORTLAND MONDAY

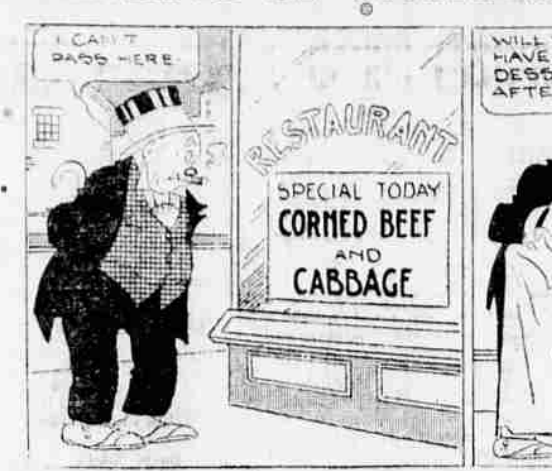

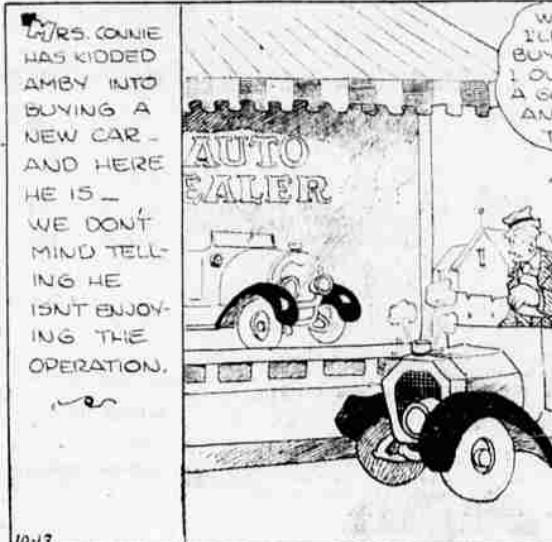
