BLIZZARD LEAVES DEATH LIST OF THREE IN WAKE

DENVER, Colo., Oct. 17.—(AP)—Winter which plagues the Rocky mountain region from mid-summer temperatures into blizzards and snow storms, left a death list of three in its wake, and seven persons are stranded on Pike's peak, unable to descend because of drifting snow which has blocked the automobile and roped up the peak.

Joe Miller, 45, a sheep herder, was frozen to death near Parkersburg, Friday. It was learned yesterday when his body was found near the flock of sheep he was guarding.

Efforts were under way today to open up the coal railroad which reaches to the top of Pike's peak, over 14,000 feet above sea level, to rescue two men and a woman who have been marooned in the shelter house on the peak since Monday.
