Party Line-up Shows Heavy Lean To G. O. P. All Precincts Except Two—Total Registry Outside Medford 13,929.

Party affiliations of the 13,929 voters of Jackson county, outside of the Medford precincts, with 4992 votes, are as follows:

Totals 1676 698 Progressives registered in Ashland were five, 18 prohibitionists, socialists seven, and miscellaneous 57.

The largest Ashland precinct is Boulevard, with a total registration of 496 votes.

Totals 456 144 Three prohibitionists, one socialist, and 18 miscellaneous are registered in the two Central Point precincts.

BROKER'S CASE GOES ON TRIAL PORTLAND COURT

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 26.—(AP)—After having been buffeted about from court to court the case of James P. Cooke, indicted president of the defunct firm of Overbeck & Cooke, went to trial today in Circuit Judge Robert S. Tucker's court.

The case was assigned yesterday to Judge Morrow by Presiding Judge Kanzler. A few minutes before the trial was to start District Attorney Stanley Myers filed an affidavit of prejudice against Judge Morrow. Judge Kanzler at once assigned the case to Judge Tucker.

Selection of a jury is expected to take the remainder of the week. Charles S. Goodwin, vice-president of the firm, recently pleaded guilty to embezzlement charges such as faced by Cooke.

Howard Philpott, secretary of the firm, is the third man accused in the indictments.

Cooke has said that he was in ill health and that Goodwin was conducting the business which brought about a loss of \$1,500,000 to customers.

Town Looted LOCKHART, Texas, Oct. 26.—(AP)—Three armed men plundered the business section of Fentress, a small town 10 miles west of Lockhart, before daybreak today, after having tied up the night watchman. Five stores were looted of thousands of dollars' worth of guns, ammunition, pocket knives, clothing and other merchandises.
