

CIRCUMSTANCES AID IN DELIVERY KILLER FROM PEN

CHICAGO, Oct. 27.—A chain of circumstances was forged in the county building yesterday down which young John Dempsey, who "killed a cop," slid to freedom from a 50 year prison sentence.

The first link was the key to the bull-pen in which Dempsey waited to testify in a case of two men for a robbery Dempsey said he himself perpetrated. "What's a robbery 'rap' when you're doing 50 years for killing a cop?" he said.

Meanwhile, the key was left in the bull pen floor, Dempsey reached a hand between the bars, turned the lock, and stepped from the pen.

The second link was the freight elevator—the only unguarded exit from the sixth floor, where Dempsey had been locked up. The elevator operator had gotten off at the fourth floor to listen to a woman in another courtroom. The elevator, it was explained, was a "reaper," moving slowly upward of its own accord. It had "crept" to the sixth floor just at the time Dempsey was seeking a way to escape. He rode to the basement and then walked from the building un molested.

Dempsey four months ago began serving a 50 year sentence for the slaying of Policeman William O'Connor. He pleaded guilty.

EDWARDSVILLE, Ill., Oct. 27.—(AP) Freddie Wooten, Illinois gangster and defendant in the numbers of Highway Patrolman Lory Price and Mrs. Price, escaped from the Madison county jail here today with Mike Kurant, who was recently granted a new trial in a murder case. The pair slipped their way out of the jail.

They cut away an iron bar of a cell in which they were confined and then sawed out another bar in a first floor window of the jail which faces the courthouse square here. They used a part of the bar of their cell to bend adjacent bars in the cell window making apertures large enough to crawl through.

The escape occurred some time between 4 a. m. and 5 a. m. this morning, and was discovered at the latter hour by the jailer, Sheriff O. H. Heermann said he had no idea how the prisoners might have obtained the saw. Wooten's wife visited him Tuesday, he said, but there was no indication she had helped him plan his escape.

PORTLAND BETS SHOW ODDS ARE GIVEN ON HOOVER

Considerable money has been placed in Portland on the result of the presidential election, as to Oregon, the nation and on New York. There have been about \$300 placed in the past five days, while about as much more is known to have been laid a month ago.

Recent bets made \$400 against \$70 that Hoover carries Oregon over Smith; \$2000 against \$1000 on the national result, Hoover to win; \$500 even that Hoover beats Smith by 30,000 in Oregon; \$125 to \$250 that Hoover beats Smith by 100,000 votes in New York state; \$250 even that Hoover breaks the solid south.
