

GAME VIOLATIONS HEAVY THIS YEAR WARDEN REPORTS

The biggest year in the history of Jackson County for the number of game violations arrests made so far in 1928 was reported today by Deputy Game Warden Roy Parr. A list of violations he had prepared, revealed 60 cases had been taken to court, returning total fines of \$1960, ranging from \$25 to \$150. One-half of this amount is to be given to the general fund of Jackson county and the other half will be turned over to the state game department.

Money is received by the county without cost of any kind and has no obligations connected with it, said Game Warden Parr this forenoon.

Of the 60 cases, which were all taken to justice court, six are still pending and four were dismissed. The majority of the arrests were made by the local officer and included arrests for angling and hunting without a license, killing deer, hunting after night, fish tagging, and illegal possession of deer meat.

An Answer To Boggs

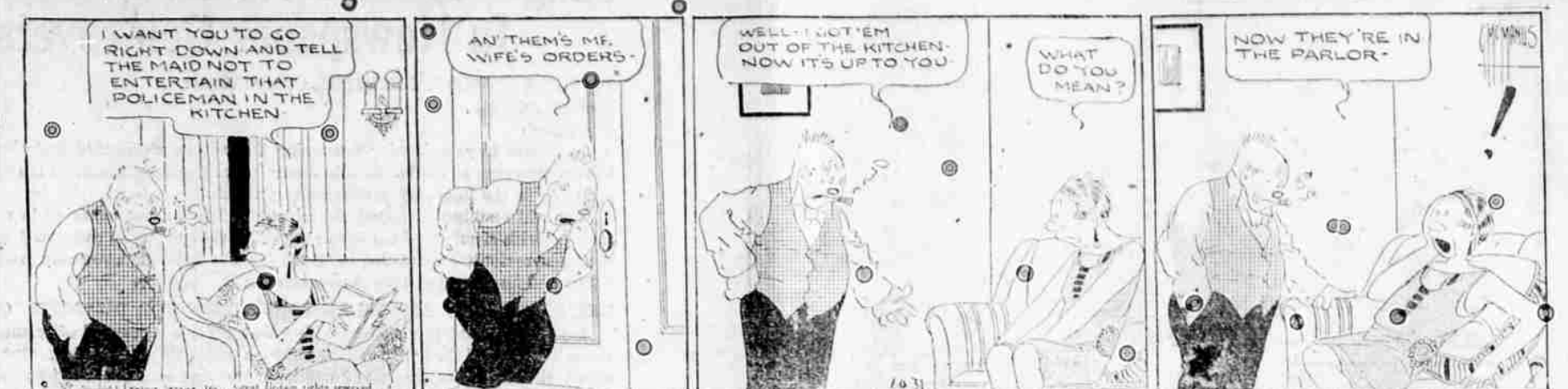

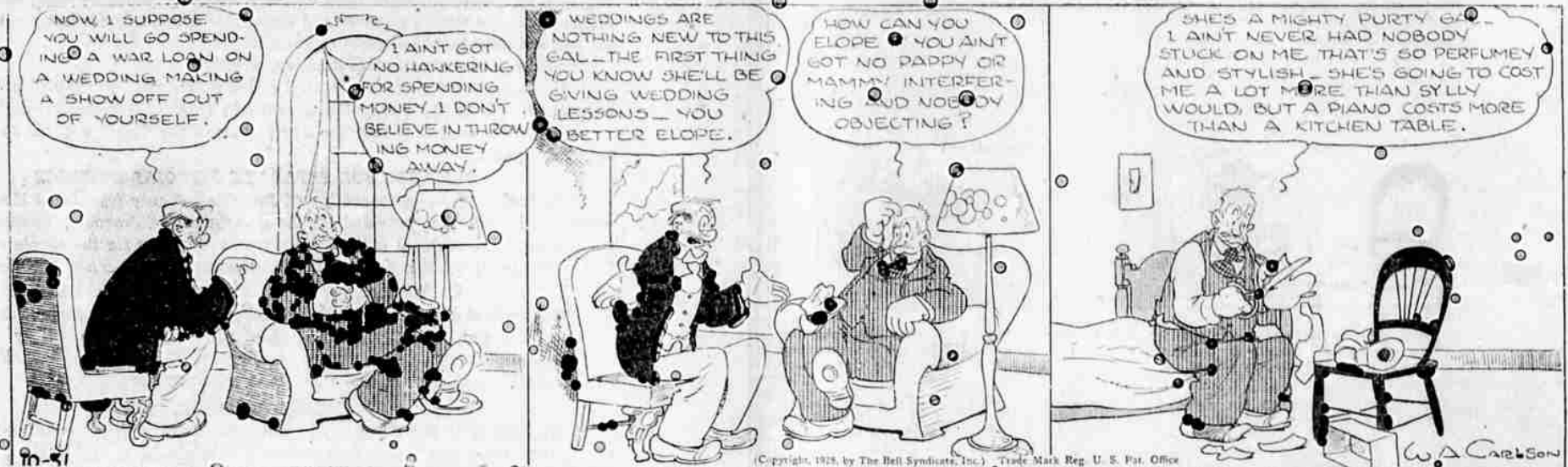
