

MEDFORD TANGLES WITH HEAVY TEAM SATURDAY'S GAME

With Benny Farrell, first string halfback out of the line-up, the Medford high school football team will tangle with the strong Corvallis high school squad, Saturday afternoon at Van Scoyoc Field. The game will start at two o'clock. There will be no radio broadcast of the game, one of the most important on the local schedule.

Bernie Hughes, center, and Melvin, quarter, will be back in the game. Hughes did not play in the Klamath Falls game, and Melvin, but for a few minutes.

The Corvallis team is the heaviest in the state, and to date has not come up to expectations, suffering two defeats and last Saturday West Linn, a tiny school, held them to a scoreless tie. The team is now reported as determined to break into the column, and also avenge the two bitter defeats of the last two years at the hands of the locals.

In Adams, halfback, and Avril, center, the visitors have two outstanding players of better than average high school ability.

The Corvallis squad of seven-teen players will arrive this afternoon by stage.

O'GRADY POINTED FOR HARD BOUT SMOKER TONIGHT

Whether or not Gene O'Grady of Ashland, southern Oregon fighting champion, will retain his unofficial title will be decided tonight when he meets Bobby Vernon, the Vancouver soldier fighter, who has been appearing with success in the Portland rings. Realizing he is to meet one of the toughest men of his career, O'Grady has prepared carefully for the battle and is expected to rush the fight from the beginning. The preliminaries will begin promptly at 8:45.

In a class of 30 pounds lighter than either Vernon or O'Grady, Pat Padelford will fight a six round semi-windup with Dud Eads, another Portland fighter. He is also expected to give the local fighter several things to worry about.

In the preliminaries, Mickey Dolan of Portland will fight four rounds with Harry Powell of Medford at 125 pounds and Frank Warency of Portland will fight Kid Wagner of Medford for four rounds at 150 pounds.

DOUBLE COUNTING BY FOUR BOARDS
