

DEMURRER FILED IN CHANEY'S SUIT FOR BOND MONEY

A demurrer to the suit of Newton C. Chaney, district attorney against Mike Hanley, Emil Mohr, J. T. Gagnon, and Dr. J. L. Helms, bondsmen of C. H. Owens, under prison sentence for his alleged part in the failure of the Bank of Jacksonville in 1921, present whereabouts unknown, was filed in the circuit court yesterday. Collection of \$2500 bonds is sought in the suit.

The demurrer is based upon the grounds that District Attorney Chaney has no legal capacity to sue; that there is insufficiency of evidence upon which to base a suit, and that the complaint is defective because Owens was not named as a defendant.

Owens was found guilty of alleged misappropriation of funds of the Bank of Jacksonville, and sentenced to serve two years in state prison. While an appeal was pending in the supreme court, Owens was at liberty on \$2500 bonds, and has not been definitely located since. He has been reported in various California cities and last year the belief was expressed by local acquaintances that he was dead.

About a year ago Jackson county started suit for the collection of the bonds, which has been pending in the courts since.

The former Medford boy will leave in a few days for Santa Barbara, where he will join the city engineer department of that city. He anticipates returning to Mexico as soon as the government activities of that country have settled to a normal state, and the construction programs resume their schedule.

Although preferring to live in the United States, Mr. Walther claims that he has found Mexico very enticing and interesting, colorful, and is looking forward to returning there in the near future.
