Screen Life in Hollywood

If the world simply must have its lens, and well and good; but hereafter some of the ingredients will come from the Hollywood studio of the screen comedian. The last of the 16 mm. trees, which once covered all the ground in the neighborhood of the studio, are being removed to make room for one of the metropolitan street sets needed in Charlie's new picture.

When Charlie bought the studio site, it was a lemon grove, like most of Hollywood before the studio came. Instead of tearing out all the trees at once, he cleared the ground a little at a time. Such portions of the orchard as were not needed in his comedy-making were allowed to continue peacefully bearing lemons. The lemons were sent out to all the world by United Artists; the lemons were distributed by one of the big growers' associations of California.

The Champion Trails. Had Charlie chosen to rubber-stamp his lemons, "Grown in the Chaplin studio at Hollywood," they doubtless would have brought in a fancy price. But he didn't and now it's too late. The lemon-shipping days of the Chaplin outfit are over.

While waiting for his sets to be completed the comedian has trained industriously for the footwork and headwork of actual production. Every day he has been running five miles along the beach near his seaside summer home, romping out the day with a swim or two in the surf and a story-conference with his staff. Those who have watched him at his workouts say the champion of comics is as fast on his feet as ever, but probably will lose the girl, as usual, to someone else in the last round of the picture.

Cinema Screams. This town will be getting a bad name if screen heroines don't use a little discretion in demonstrating their fitness for talking picture roles. Several directors preparing to make talking thrillers are insisting on girls who can scream well for the microphone. So the screen tests and interviews which go on during the casting period have developed into noisy events, full of shrieks and hysterical yells. RANSOM BELIEVED ABDUCTION MOTIVE IN DETROIT, MICH.

DETROIT, Nov. 28.—(AP) Belief that Benjamin Jacobs, 28, head of a "hotting" swindle here, who was kidnaped from his office late yesterday by three men in held for ransom, was expressed today by police.

No word has come from Jacobs or his abductors since the kidnapping and no motive, except that of ransom, has been advanced. Samuel Jacobs, brother of the victim, witnessed the kidnapping. He said the three men entered the office, drew revolvers and forced his brother to accompany them to an automobile which was parked in front of the establishment. They then drove away. The brother said the gunman threatened to kill him if he interfered.

So far as police have been able to learn, they said the kidnaped man had no enemies and had received no threats.
