

CHAMPION STEER BRINGING UP FATHER

CHICAGO, Dec. 6.—A record-breaking price for the grand champion steer of the International Livestock exposition was paid today when the Hereford yearling owned by Clarence Goswick, 12 years old, of State Center, Iowa, was knocked down on the auction block for seven dollars and a half. The previous high price, paid in 1926, was \$4.50 a pound. Today's purchaser was the J. C. Penney company of New York.

The youthful owner saw his pet, which he had raised from a calf, auctioned off with a solemn face, despite the fact that the price paid meant he would receive more than \$8,999 in addition to over \$1,000 prize money he already has received.

The warding of the grand champion automatically seals the death warrant for the recipient which, according to custom is auctioned off and butchered at the stockyards.

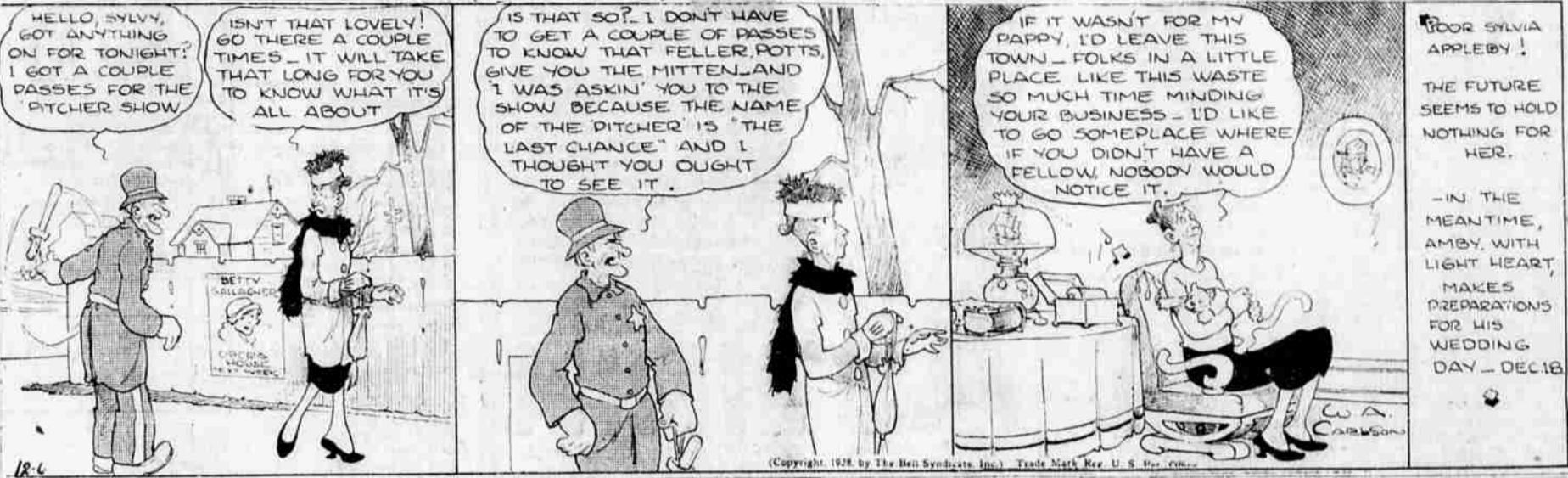
