The screen attraction will be "Joseph Mendou in 'His Private Life'."

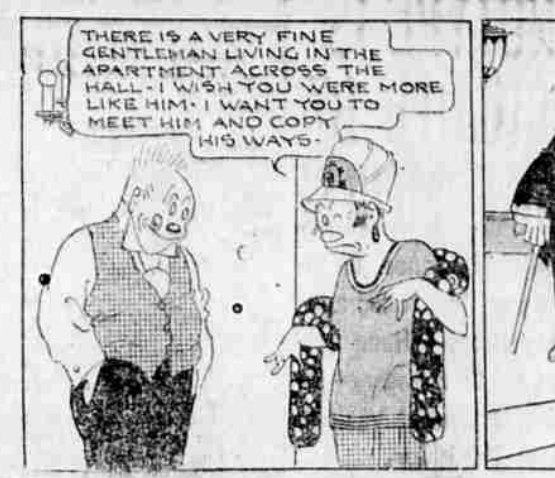
GRANT CATTLE RAISERS BOTHERED BY RUSTLERS

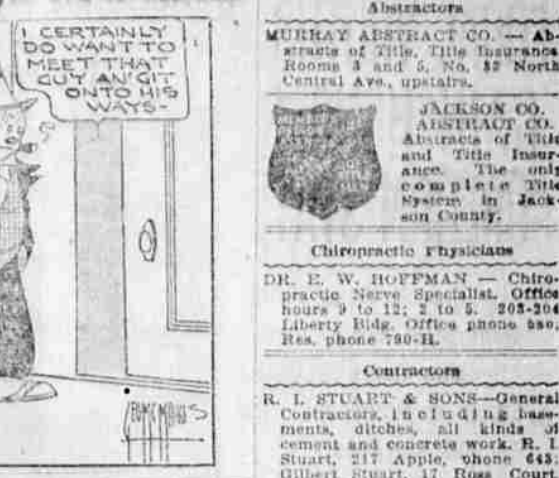
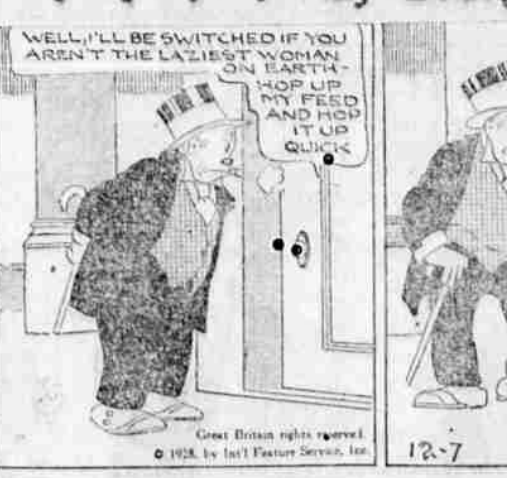

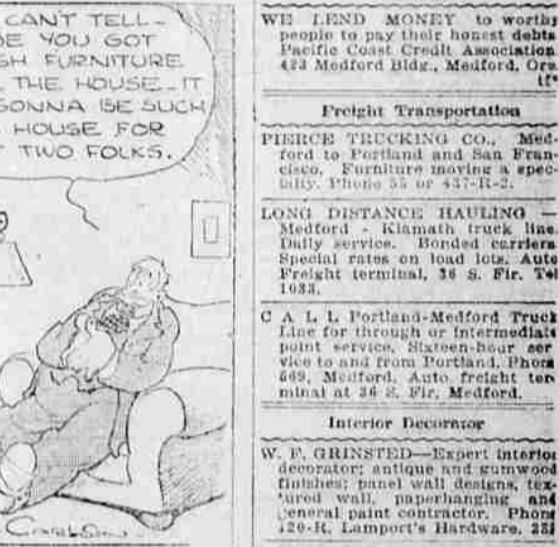
