The friends of Mr. and Mrs. W. P. Grimes are glad to know they are able to be up again.

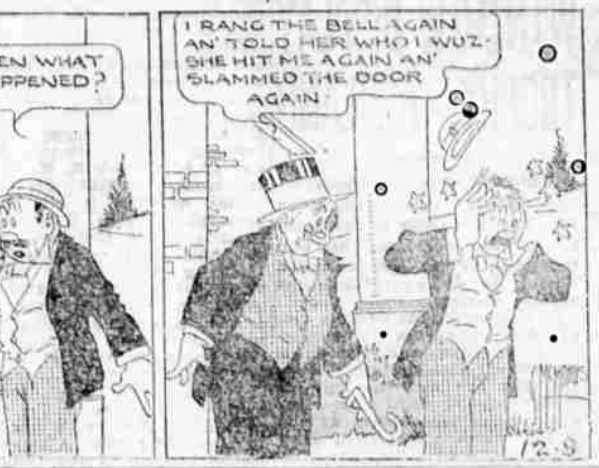
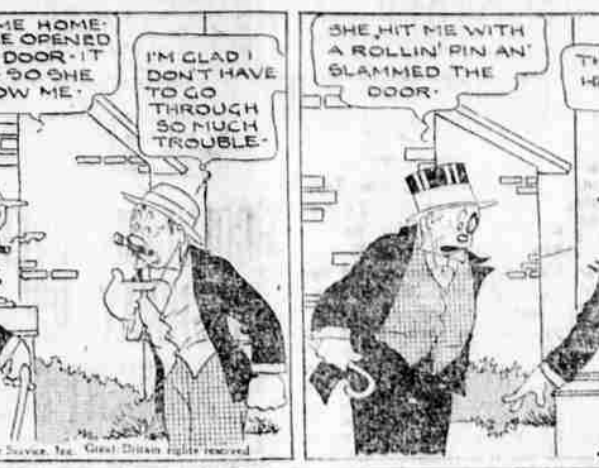
Miss Erna Hamrick of Portland arrived Monday evening to spend several weeks with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. B. Hamrick.

The first basketball game of the season will be played this (Friday) evening at 8 o'clock, between the Central Point and Butte Falls teams.

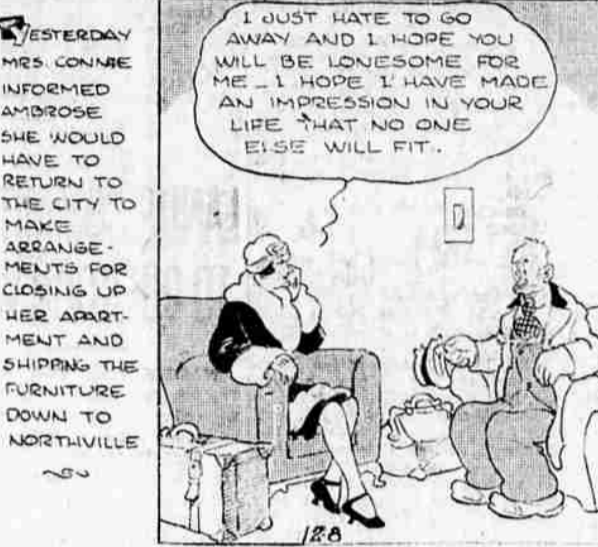
