SMALL SNOWFALL CAUSE FOR WORRY AMONG OFFICIALS

Because of the deficiency of snow so far at Crater National park at this time of year, also in the other high mountain territory surrounding the Rogue River valley...

There is only two and one-half feet of snow at the south National park entrance and four feet at the 2900-foot level...

It is raining at the Crater National park today, and the temperatures prevailing there last month and so far this month are far too high for winter weather in that region.

The coldest day of December in the park was 6 degrees above on December 15, and the temperature during the month has averaged around 29 degrees above in the day-time.

There is no snow in the Klamath valley.

NON-RESIDENT AUTO PERMITS RECEIVED FOR TOURISTS' USE

Non-resident automobile permits were received here today by L. C. Garlock, in charge of the registration of out-of-state cars, in the Chamber of Commerce building, automobile division, along with instructions for this year in issuing such permits to tourists and others.

While the instructions are practically the same as last year, the design of the permit is far different this year.

The new permit is yellow on a green background, with a picture of snow-capped Mount Hood in the center.

Above the picture appear the words "State of Oregon," and below the picture are the words "Oregon's Year Around Playground."

Of course, the people of Medford and other parts of the valley would rather the design had a picture of Crater Lake than Mt. Hood.

It is understood that the secretary of state's office, automobile division, before selecting the above design, looked over other designs submitted by the various local managers of the out-of-state registration plants, by request, and from others.

Mr. Garlock and others from the southern Oregon section, naturally submitted designs with Crater Lake as the main feature, but the powers that be at Salem decided that the northern end of the state should be featured, with Mt. Hood, as more distinctive.
