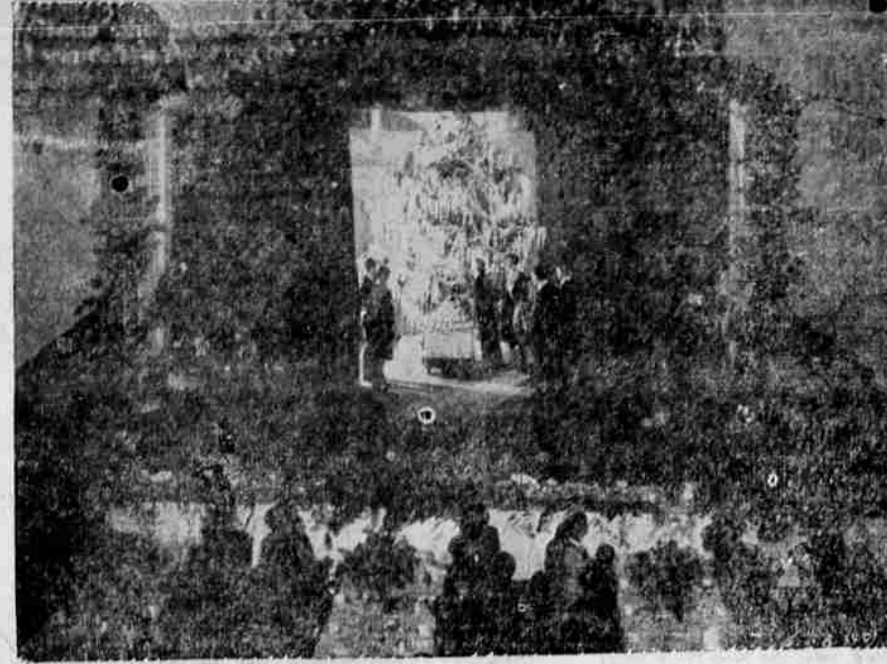


AIR CROWDED BOARD PLANS NO DRASTIC CUT
