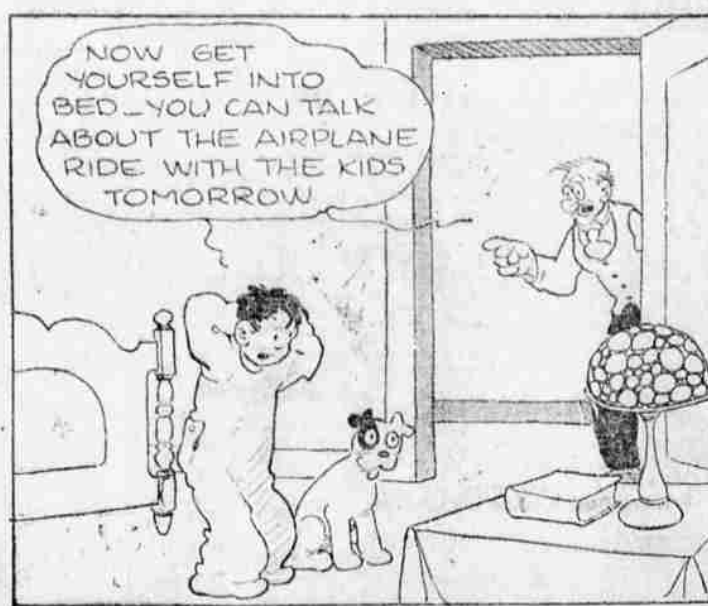

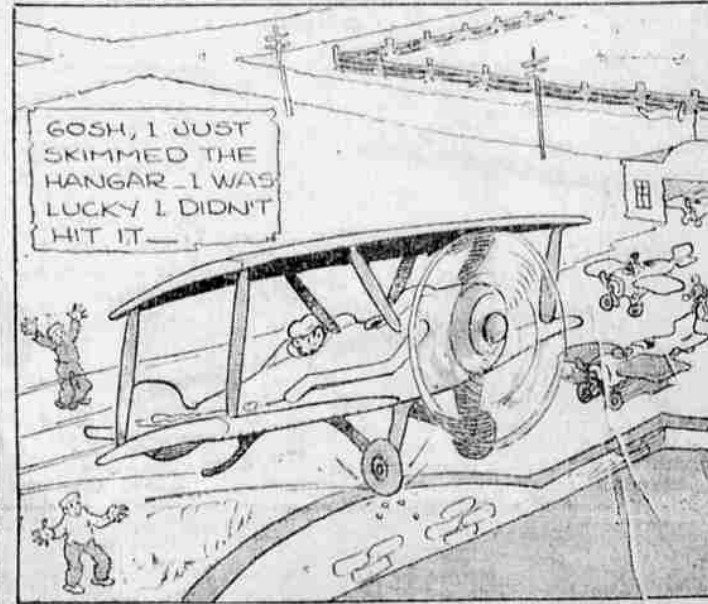

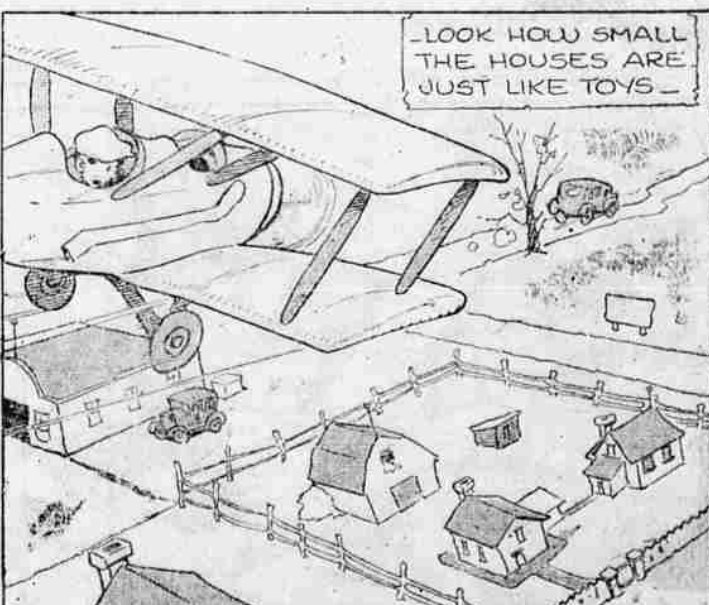
I'LL JUST TAKE THE OLD MACHINE OUT FOR A LITTLE AIRING

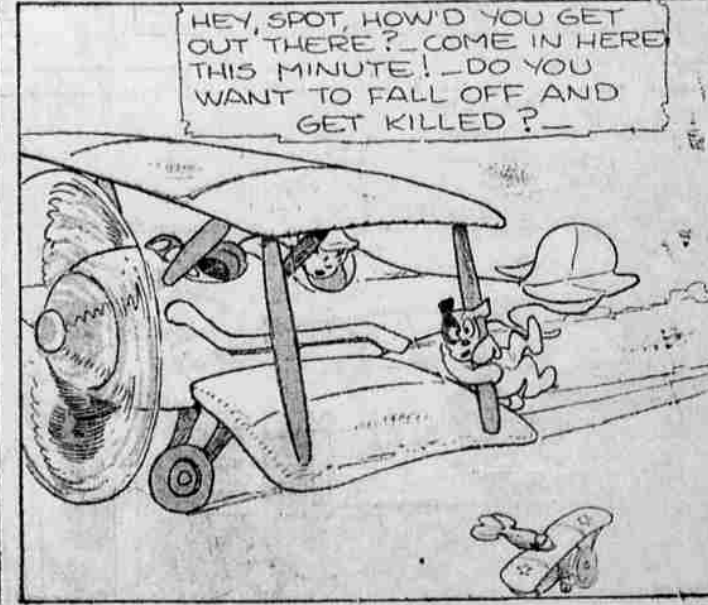
GOSH, I JUST SKIMMED THE HANGAR - I WAS LUCKY I DIDN'T HIT IT -
