

GOLD HILL LIME DEVELOPMENT ON EXTENSIVE BASIS

GOLD HILL Ore., Feb. 8.—(Special).—The Lively Lime Products company of Gold Hill is now undertaking several new and extensive developments upon their works, located three miles up Kanes creek.

Among the main operations is the opening up of a new quarry, situated in the vicinity of the present base of their lime operations. The new quarry is being opened up in what was formerly an old tunnel. It extends about 150 feet back into the earth. The main operations in present consist of widening out the tunnel. A number of men, including an extra crew, is being employed in the work.

The rock being taken out now is mostly of shale formation and it is estimated that a tunnel of about 200 feet will have to be made before they will reach the real lime formation. After it is reached the main operations will be started and another tunnel of several feet will be drilled into the lime formation. At present, as fast as the old tunnel is being reopened and widened out it is being reinforced with heavy timbers.

The present quarry is now open and being worked in full operation. The old quarry is several hundred feet back in the earth and will not be abandoned, but will be worked as steadily as it is being worked at present. This will furnish employment for an extra crew at the new quarry.

Among the other improvements being made at the plant and the burner, is the installation of electricity, which work was begun about a month or so ago. A crew of about 20 men is employed digging the postholes and hauling the posts to their respective locations. The line will follow the new road which was recently built and will go from the Willow Springs road direct to the burner.

The truck used to haul the lime rock from the quarry on Kanes Creek to Gold Hill is now kept in steady operation. The rock is being shipped to several different points in Oregon and is being used in the manufacture of paper.

About eighteen cars were shipped from Gold Hill last month.

It is expected that the number sent in the month of February will greatly exceed the quota sent out in January since the opening of the new tunnel will greatly increase the amount of lime rock which can be taken out. It is expected the line will be taken from the new quarry within the next few weeks and that this will greatly increase their volume. The burner will also start in the very near future.

An extra day crew is being put on to rush the work on the new operations and as soon as they are completed the efficiency of the plant will be greatly increased and they will be able to cope with the increasing demand for the Lively Lime company's products.

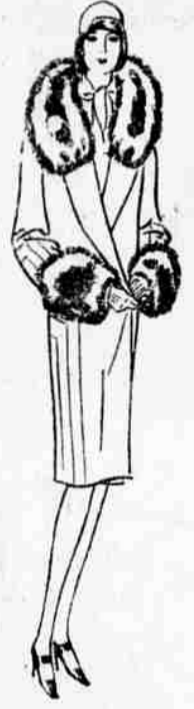
