

OIL DEVELOPMENT IN PROSPECT FOR MEDFORD VICINITY

Development of the oil producing possibilities of the Rogue River valley, adjacent to this city, are now underway, and oil and gas leases for approximately 2500 acres of land, have been secured by H. P. Meyers of Portland, and 425 in section in the Medford National bank. Most of the leased land is in the Coker Butte district, and among the heaviest leases is W. H. Gore.

Mr. Meyers agrees to start drilling operations, as soon as 5000 acres have been signed. Slightly more than half this amount has been secured, and more leases are expected to be consummated within a very short period.

It has also come to light that recently a "plane table" was made by two geologists of the Rogue River valley. A "plane table" shows the formation and lay of the strata. After a study of this map, Meyers, an experienced oil man, was impressed with the prospects.

Preliminary work in the project has been going on quietly for several months.

Last fall 100 local business men signed notes for \$1000 each to be delivered for the bringing in of an oil well that produced 2500 barrels of oil for 10 consecutive days. Mr. Meyers asked that these bonus contracts be assigned to him, in the happy event that success crowned his drilling operations, and it was so agreed.

Meyers asks no financial assistance, and has his own drilling outfit.
