

CALIFORNIA URGED COMPLETE ROADS TO OREGON'S LINE

SALEM, Ore., Feb. 22.—(AP) The state of California is urged to complete its connecting links with the four north and south highways now running through the state of Oregon in house joint memorial 14, introduced Thursday evening by representative Collier of Klamath Falls.

It is to the mutual interest of the great states of California and Oregon that connecting links be forthwith authorized and constructed in California with these Oregon roads," says the memorial which is directed to the legislature of the state of California.

Unimproved roads now exist on the California side between the Roosevelt highway in Oregon and the California-Bendwood highway, says the memorial; between the Pacific highway in Oregon and on the California side; on the Klamath Falls-Weed highway for the Oregon line to Weed; on the Dallas-California highway from the Oregon line to Alturas, Cal. The Fremont highway in Oregon is completed from Lakeview to California Mine, says the memorial, but there is no connection with any logical California terminus.
