

### OBSERVER CASTS DOUBT ON STORY OF MARCH ENTRY

Dick, meteorologist of the local weather bureau and who is himself an American, despite the fact he lived in St. Louis for years, tersely throws the issue in doubt.

"Today's weather is very lamb-like. Will it go out like a lion?" asked the news-anchorman of Mr. Dick, who was poring over some meteorological records in the U. S. weather office.

"Baloney," he remarked without looking up.

"You don't understand," persisted the reporter. "I am asking about this lamb and lion business."

"You're right, it's being business," said without looking up.

"But Mr. Dick, you swore to uphold the constitution and you certainly must have heard about the old adage. Is it scientifically correct?"

"Very busy," said Kenneth, was his reply.

The reporter then put the question to Kenneth Anderson, minor observer of the weather bureau.

"Duh-wah," a Greek word meaning foolishness, was the latter's only reply. Then perceiving that his questioner felt hurt at the attitude of the weather sharks, the 220-pound minor observer said:

"Paraphrasing speaking, but not scientifically, I can state with absolute certainty that the United States weather bureau officially or unofficially takes no cognizance of this adage business."

Then Mr. Dick finally came out in the open, saying: "You can take your choice as to the truth of the adage, or how it works out. In some sections of the country it does work out, sometimes, and sometime it does not. You can tell the people that they can take their choice."

All the above of which is prefatory to stating that today was an ideal day like in early spring, and that cloudy weather is forecast for tonight and Saturday with normal temperature. Yesterday's maximum was 62 above and this morning's maximum at 5 o'clock was 22.

SALEM, Ore., March 1.—(AP)—Dr. W. H. Lytle, state veterinarian, said today that an investigator working out of his office would reach LaGrande tonight in an effort to check up on the cause of the poisoning of two men and the loss of livestock from a strange malady there.

It is doubtful whether the malady is the same which caused considerable loss of livestock in Sherman county and the surrounding area during the past year, the state veterinarian said. Some symptoms pointing to some form of chemical poison in the feed had been found in the Sherman county cases.
