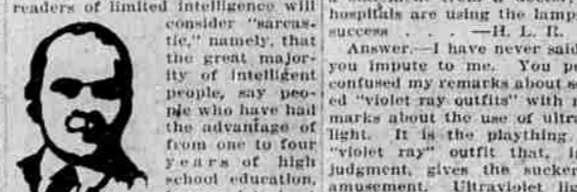

Randolph Safford of Ellensburg, former pastor of the First Methodist church in Medford, opposed Judge Ben Lindsey, proponent of companionate marriage and birth control, in a discussion on these subjects here last night.
