

**ANDREW CANTRALL
BELOVED PIONEER
OF JACKSON DEAD**

Andrew Cantrall, 89, beloved pioneer of Jackson county, who passed away at the home of his nephew, James Cantrall, in Jacksonville yesterday, will be mourned by a great number of friends and older residents in southern Oregon.

Mr. Cantrall, who was born in Lake county, Illinois, January 11, 1846, came to Oregon in 1866 and lived with his brother, John, on the Applegate for a few years. At that time, the Little Applegate district was a wilderness, but Mr. Cantrall, with true pioneer spirit, took up a homestead there and cleared over 200 acres of land by himself. He was extensively engaged in stock raising for a number of years.

In 1890 he married Mrs. Anna Yantis, an aunt of Attorney Gus Newbury, who passed away in 1921, since which time he has lived with his nephew, James Cantrall in Jacksonville.

Mr. Cantrall possessed that sturdy integrity characteristic of all the early pioneers, and his word was accepted by stockmen and business men throughout southern Oregon. He was extremely broadminded and tolerant of the opinions of others, and for this reason endeared himself to all who knew him.

Mrs. N. A. Bacheider of Portland, is the only surviving member of a family of 12 brothers and sisters, left. She arrived in the city this morning to attend the funeral, set for 2:30 p. m. Saturday, at the Perl Funeral Home. Her children, Elsie Bacheider, A. C. Bacheider, J. Bacheider, F. G. Bacheider, Thomas G. Bacheider of Portland, and Mrs. Florence Conklin of Hoquiam, Washington will also arrive to attend the services.

**NOTED RECITALIST TO
INTRODUCE HIS LATEST
WORK AT LOCAL ORGAN**

That John Stark Evans, famous organist, who is to play the opening recital on the Reuter organ installed in the new Sacred Heart church here, Palm Sunday afternoon at 4 o'clock, will introduce for the first time one of his most recent compositions as a special feature of the program, is an interesting bit of news received here today.

Another very charming modern organ composition on this program will be "Bells of St. Anne de Beaupre" (by Russell). Mr. Russell is organist at Princeton university and director of music at Wanamaker's. This composition is from his suite of "St. Lawrence Sketches." The church of St. Anne at Beaupre, Canada, has been noted for many years as the "Lourdes of America" because of the miraculous cures said to have been effected at the shrine. The edifice was destroyed a few years ago by fire.

The program of this composition is as follows: Traditional chimes played at St. Anne's; gathering of the faithful; chanting of the choir; the procession; the miracle; benediction; bells in the distance. Mr. Evans' interpretation of this number is said to make the picture so realistic that the audience needs no preliminary preparation to follow the entire theme.
