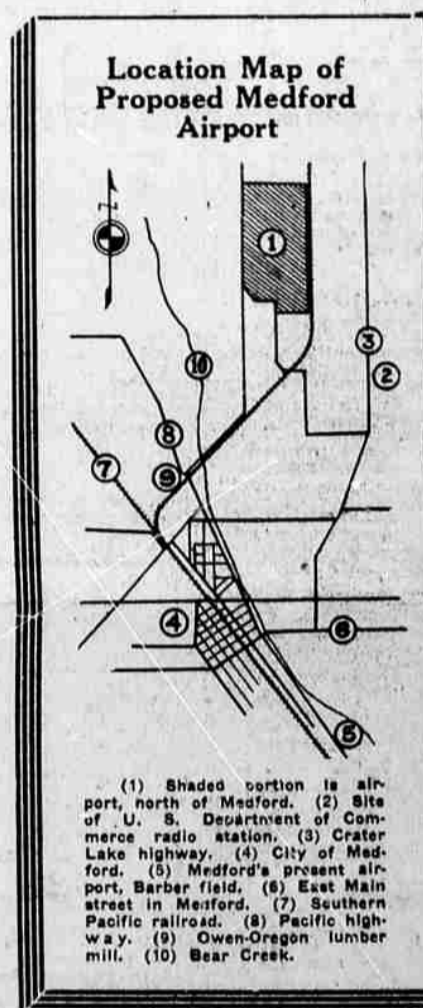
Medford Is Benefiting By Air Development

CITIES that have responded to progressive movements in the past and prepared therefor, have profited. The greatest progress of the age today is being made in air transportation. Medford responded a few years ago by putting in the first airport in Oregon. This was recognized by the air mail service and Medford had the first air mail port in the state. The government recognized the fact also, and established the first upper air meteorological weather bureau on the coast here. It now wants to locate one of the 17 super-radio stations in the United States, with a 24-hour service here, also a 24-hour full weather bureau and one of the large beacon lights, at a total cost of \$100,000, and all it asks is that Medford put in an adequate port for the safe landing of all sizes of planes, without which a radio station, weather bureau or beacon lights will not be needed.

The average annual tax to Medford people on a \$1000 valuation should soon approximate \$1.50. There is every reason to believe that the Medford airport will soon be self-supporting and, eventually, a substantial revenue producer.

As a business proposition, disregarding the prestige the new airport will give this city and the many other benefits it offers, Medford people should not hesitate to vote for the bonds.
