"LENA" HOLDING WHIP HAND IN SOX REBELLION

Old Roman Backs Blackburne — Art Shires Sent Home to Gain Condition — Cissell Is Reinstated — Grumbling Subsidies.

DALLAS, Texas, April 3.—(AP)—Rebellion among the White Sox players is at an end today with Russell Blackburne, manager of the club, in the role of supreme dictator.

Blackburne, backed up by Chas. A. Comiskey, owner of the club, ordered Art Shires, one of the rebels, home to remain at his own expense until he gets in condition to play baseball. Bill Cissell, the young shortstop, charged with violating training rules, was reinstated.

Blackburne's action of suspending the pair, and then following it up by ordering Shires, a promising first baseman, to leave camp, seems to have produced a silencing effect on certain players who have grumbled over the inconveniences of playing exhibition games in small Texas towns.

The Sox manager, invoking stern measures to insure discipline and smash the wave of dissatisfaction gaining impetus in the Sox ranks, dismissed Shires after a long distance telephone conversation with Comiskey, the "Old Roman," in Chicago.

Shires, rated as one of the best prospects coming to the American league in recent years, was made acting field captain two weeks ago and then stripped of his rank for insubordination. He is said to be in no condition as a result of keeping late hours and breaking other training rules.
