He is now 'up and about' and recovered sufficiently for the venture into the wilds.

"Several days after the first operation complications developed, which resulted in a second operation. Since then Ben has been recovering strength steadily, though slowly.

"At Devil's lake he will be in the habitat his pen has done so much to popularize among the Oregonian readers, a mixture of mountain, lake and seashore. He is best known for his whimsical, and yet learned, editorials upon Oregon wild life. Further, he is poet, assessor and reporter. He has had articles and poems in Nature magazine, the Saturday Evening Post, Sunset, Outdoor Recreation, the Dearborn Independent and other national publications. His book, 'How Could I Be Forgetting,' has enjoyed much popularity.

"Many people learned of Mr. Lampman's absence from his desk simply through not finding his characteristic editorials upon frogs, strawberries, ducks, trout, sea urchins and other things of the kind on the editorial page.

"Mr. Lampman said yesterday that, under the benign influence of the Devil's lake country, he expected to be back in the office within a very few weeks."

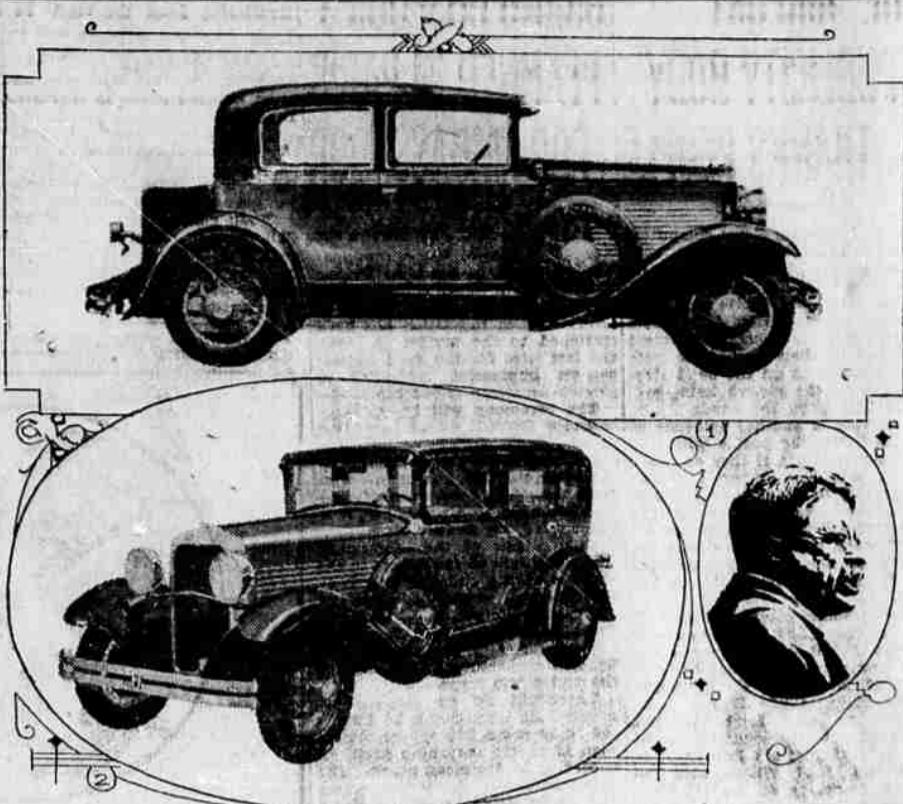
John Carkin Called Pilot of New Tax Law

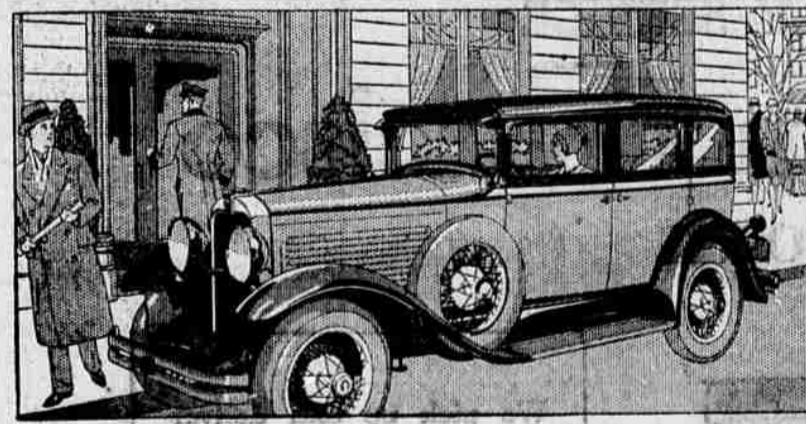
