

WALL ST. UPSET BY RUMORS MOTOR POOL HITS SNAG

NEW YORK, April 6.—(AP) Stock prices were churned about in rather erratic fashion today in reflection of the extensive readjustment of speculative accounts. Prices generally headed downward, but rallied later when fresh buying operations appeared in some of the popular oil and railroad shares. Acute weakness cropped out in a few high priced specialties which dropped 5 to 20 points. Speculative sentiment was unquieted by the circulation of unconfirmed rumors that a large operator, who was sponsoring a pool in a motor stock, had met with financial difficulties. While there were no new developments in the credit situation, many large and small traders were reported to be reducing their long commitments on the theory that a major upswing was unlikely. While the market was under the threat of the Federal Reserve board that unless there was voluntary co-operation by the banks in obtaining a reduction of brokers' borrowings it "may adopt other methods of influencing the situation."
