

KLAMATH FORGER SENT UP FOR THREE YEARS

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore., April 9.—Sentence of three years in state prison was imposed today on William M. Randall, who entered a plea of guilty to a charge of forgery. Randall has served one term in Walla Walla penitentiary.

Shortly before he entered his plea he attempted to swallow a quantity of fly-killing connection. His wife, Rose Randall, is being held on a forgery charge.
