

STATE EMPLOYEES AUTO ALLOWANCE WILL BE CLIPPED

SALEM, Ore., May 14.—(AP) State employees who have been charging the state ten cents a mile for official trips in their privately-owned automobiles between Salem and Portland, or \$10 for the trip, will hereafter have this reimbursement for motor vehicle expense cut to \$2.50, declare members of the state board of control. The latter amount is the price of round trip railroad fare.

HEINRICH DISCOVERS POISON CRYSTALS IN RABLEN'S DEATH CUP

SONORA, Calif., May 14.—(AP) Science in the form of a report by E. O. Heinrich, Berkeley criminologist, has entered a foothill murder mystery here. Heinrich analyzed a coffee cup from which Carroll Rablen drank shortly before his death at Tuttle town on the night of April 26, and announced the cup contained a sufficient amount of poison to cause death.

ECLIPSE PHOTOGRAPHS PROVE SATISFACTORY

ALOR STAR, Kedah, Malay States, May 14.—(AP) The developed plates of photographs taken of the eclipse on Thursday by the British observation party have proved better than was expected. The transparency proved to have been equal to that at Gloucester, Yorkshire, in the 1927 eclipse, and there were several beautiful prominences, one 150,000 miles long and 100,000 miles high with coronal arches.

JUDGE BLASTS HOPE LOWER PHONE RATES

PORTLAND, Ore., May 14.—(AP) Prospects of lower telephone rates in Portland today appeared to have been blasted. In federal court Judge Bean today ruled that the city has no right whatever to fix or attempt to fix rates established by any public service company any right to accept such terms. To do so, the court held, would result in a violation of the utility law and officers of the firm would become liable.
