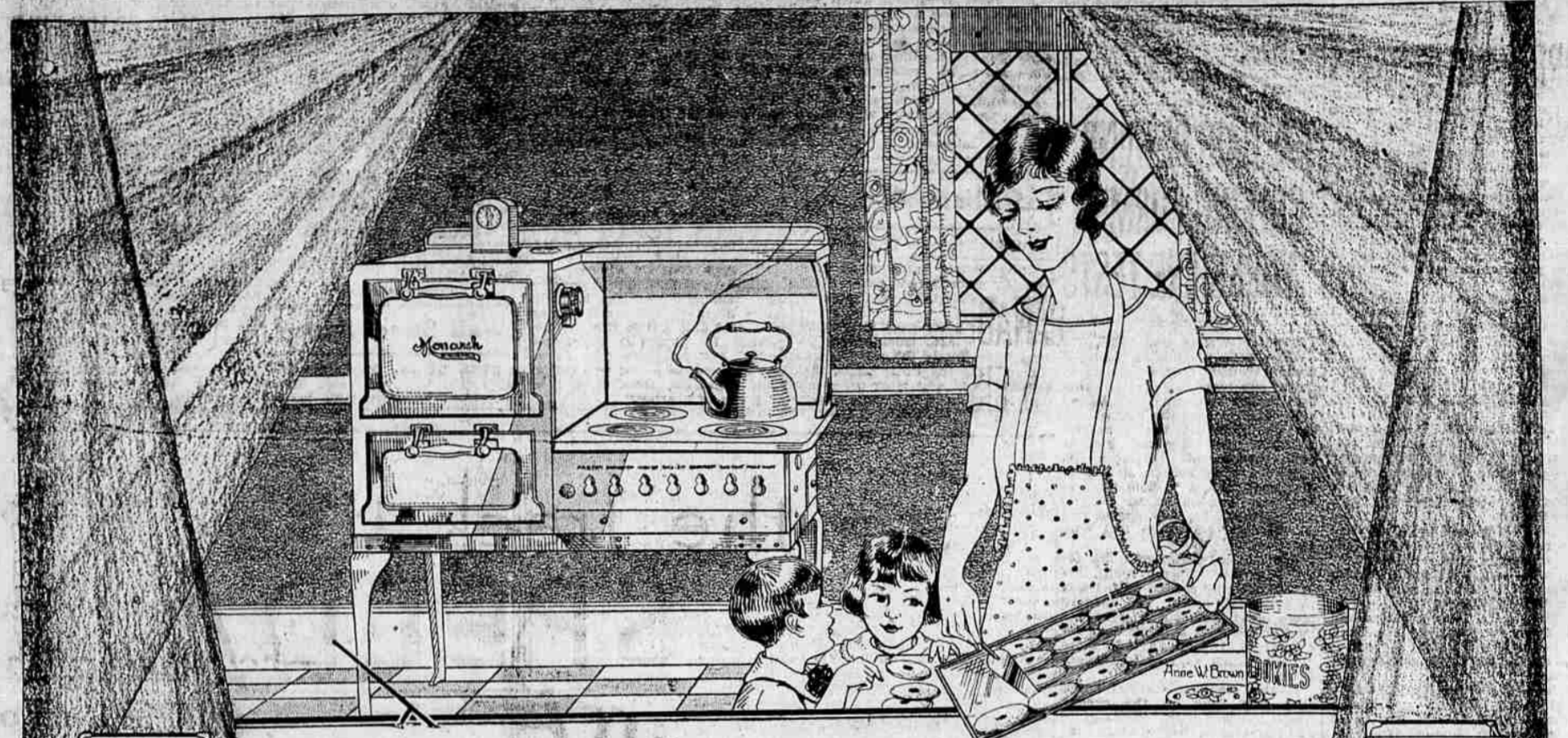
IMMIGRATION DIRECTOR EXONERATED IN PLOT
