The first prize will be a \$12.75 walnut finished rocker with spring seat. Second prize will be a \$10 pottery table lamp, and third prize will be a \$6.75 set of dishes.

### MALING CANNERY USER OF VALLEY PEARS, IS RAZED

HILLSBORO, Ore., May 17.—(AP) Fire last night destroyed the main building of the Ray Maling cannery here, with a loss of \$300,000. Full insurance was covered. A red hot rivet dropped on an asphalt-covered slab of cork was said to have started the blaze.

New machinery valued at \$175,000, ready for installation in the cooling room, was believed ruined.

The Ray Maling company is one of the heaviest buyers of cannery pears in the Rogue River valley, but the fire, according to C. M. Speck, local cannery representative, is not expected to cause any curtailment of the buying program, as the cannery has another large plant at Woodburn. The latter is new and is much larger than the Hillsboro cannery. It is probable the company will rebuild as soon as possible, said Mr. Speck.

### HIGHWAY TRAFFIC MORE THAN 1928

Traffic over the Pacific highway is slightly greater than at this time last year, according to Wm. Drummond, foreman of the state highway maintenance crew between Medford and the California line.

The 16-hour traffic check, made monthly, was made Tuesday and showed 2554 cars passing over the Pacific highway at a point a mile south of Medford, from 6 a. m. to 10 p. m.

The check at the Klamath Junction, showed 579 cars north-bound over the Pacific highway, and 409 cars southbound. There were 421 cars to pass over the Greenspring highway.

This monthly check shows traffic over the Pacific highway to be second heaviest in the state.

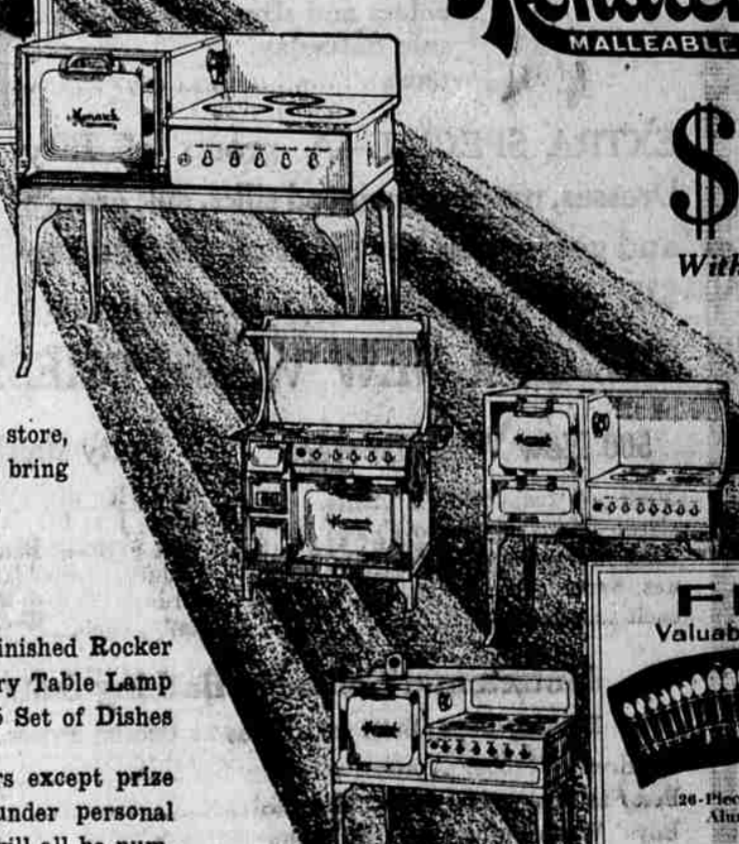

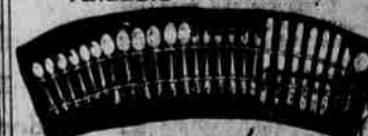
