FIND OCEAN DEPTH ABLE TO SWALLOW COLORADO'S PRIDE

WASHINGTON (AP)—Unsuspected ocean depths, in which Pike's peak with its 14,180 feet of height would be topped by 4,000 feet of water, have been discovered off the Peruvian coast.

The ship, which has been out since May 1, 1928, now is near Pago Pago, American Samoa, on its way to Japan.
