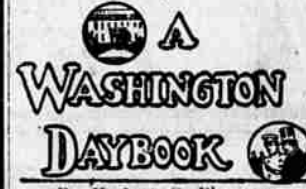

By Author's Request There is no legal tie that compels Putnam to keep this edition secret, but Lawrence's request will be respected.
