Wall Street Report

NEW YORK, May 25.—(P)—Frequent shifts of speculative sentiment in today's stock market reflected the widespread uneasiness among professional traders over the credit situation. Prices opened irregular, turned abruptly downward before the end of the first hour, and then more irregular recovery.

Heavy buying of Commonwealth Power, which ran up nearly 10 points to a new high at 169 1/2, checked the decline in the last hour. The closing was irregular. Total sales approximately 1,200,000 shares.
