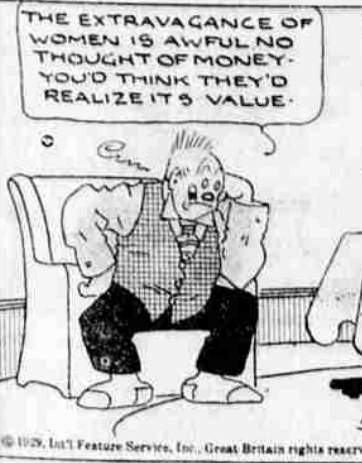


MAZE DAMAGES WEBSTER HOME VALENT, SUNDAY
