Treating seed potatoes with cor resive sublimate to get rid of sur-face borne discases may be done some time before planting without decreasing its offectiveness, advises the Oregon experiment station. It is necessary that the potatoes be treated whole and that the eyes chould not have begun to grow at fiould not have begun to grow at he time, as injury to growing points and germination may result.

During the warm days of spring Oregon, lice and miles multiply a Oregon, lice and hard around rapidly on the chicken® and around the roosting quarters. The best treatment for body lice is to paint the roots with black leaf forty ust before the chickens go on for has ordere the endexes go on total the night. One application will last two days and will rid the fowls of lice. Painting the under side of the roos s and connections with undificient carbolineum or sheep dip over will eliminate miles, says the experiment station.
