NEW YORK, June 1.—(P)—The stock market ran into considerable week-end liquidation and closed irregular after a quiet half day session today, although the reduction of \$222,000,000 in brokers' loans caused a moderate upturn throughout the list in the first hour. Operations were curtailed by the fact that many traders, driven from town by the hot weather, extended the Memorial holiday over the week-end. Such issues as General Electric, Curtiss Aero, Greene Tannery, Columbian Carbon, Union Carbide, F. G. Shattuck and Western Union mounted from 2 to nearly 4 points. Radio, however, dropped 3 points to 84, a new low for the movement, and General Motors, Packard and Auburn autos lost from 1 to 2 points. Chrysler rallied nearly 3 points in the first hour, but lost most of its gain later. An reduction dropped 2 1/2 points. Total sales approximated but 1,400,000 shares. Oregon Weather.
