

MILLION DOLLAR MILL CITY TO BE LOCATED IN EASTERN OREGON

PORTLAND, Ore., June 15.—One million dollars will build a city in the heart of eastern Oregon.

The Stafford, Berles & Roy Co., said to be one of the largest subdivision development companies of New Orleans, has opened offices here and has announced that it contemplates expenditure of \$1,000,000 in building a new residential and business community adjacent to the \$4,000,000 lumber mill being constructed near Burns, Ore., by the Times interests of Chicago.

The new community, it is said, will be located along the Central Oregon highway. It will be developed in such a way that it ultimately will be joined with the city of Burns. The lines will be a half and a half from Burns.

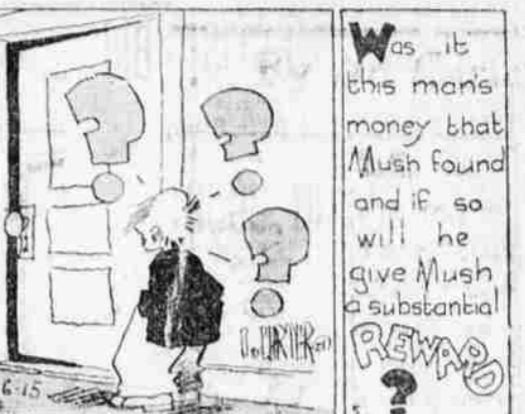

WIDE VARIANCE PRICE OF PORTLAND BERRIES

PORTLAND, Ore., June 15.—(AP) Strawberry prices were the most confusing in the present market situation. A big wholesale house Saturday quoted berries from \$1 to \$1.50 a crate, depending on quality, and reported that the fruit to be unusually scarce at these figures. Yet berries could be purchased cheaper at retail stands. Some of these were quoted at four and five boxes for 25 cents. The difference in price is said to be accounted for by the wide variance in quality. Berry supplies were well cleaned up, and Friday and Saturday did not promise abundant replenishment. If Sunday brings warm sunshine, it was expected that Monday will see the market loaded with berries of good quality.
