

WILL SPAN ROGUE AT WEDDERBURN

MARSHFIELD, Ore., June 22.—(AP)—A bridge to cost approximately \$500,000 will be constructed across the Rogue river on the Oregon Coast Highway. The state highway commission yesterday went over the ground and reached this decision. The bridge will not be completed, however, before three years, and will require from 18 months to two years to construct. The bridge will be at Wedderburn on the north side of the Rogue, and a little east of Gold Beach on the south bank.

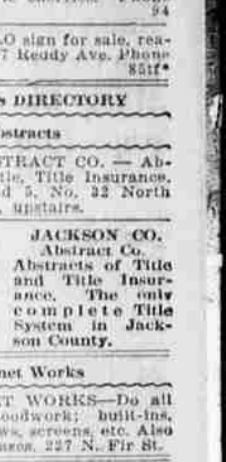
