

THREE TEACHERS ARE SACKED FOR STAGING "PARTY"

BELLINGHAM, Wash., June 28. (AP)—For "conduct unbecoming teachers," three members of the Bellingham Normal school faculty were dismissed last night by the board of trustees.

They were Arthur Kolstad, psychology teacher; Oscar O. Wither, Oregon and Harvard university graduate and history instructor; and Miss Helen S. Dozier, a Mills college, Oakland, graduate, and of the Normal physical education department.

The dismissal grew out of an investigation conducted by President C. H. Fisher, after Kolstad and a few nights ago caused the arrest of William Kahke, Seattle banker, and T. Ward, Seattle contractor, on assault charges, claiming they waylaid and "beat him up." The Seattle man objected to Kolstad's association with Kahke's 13-year-old daughter, a student at the Normal.

Ward is her stepfather. President Fisher said investigation disclosed that the three dismissed faculty members and the Kahke girl staged a "wild party" at Kolstad's home recently.
