

### COPCO WILL GIVE FINEST PROGRAM OF YEAR TONIGHT

One of the best Copco radio programs of the year is scheduled for tonight from 9 to 10 o'clock, presenting a group of radio artists who would do credit to any metropolitan broadcast. Headliners on the "Copco hour" will include Axel Jorgensen, famous Danish baritone and Victor recording artist; Dick Posey, the "Poet of the Rodeo," well known chautauque artist; Miss Elbow Mae Wilson, soprano, winner of the state high school contest and also winner of the recent Atwater Kent foundation radio contest, and Geo. Peckham, basso, winner of a similar Atwater Kent contest for men. Mrs. George Andrews, well known pianist of Medford, will accompany the soloists and Earl Davis will act as official announcer for this feature program.

Mr. Jorgensen, who has appeared on the concert stage in Europe, Australia and Canada, as well as in this country, is well known to the radio public of the west, having broadcast over some of the leading stations in Los Angeles, San Francisco, Seattle and other large cities. He has arranged a special program for his part in "Copco hour," featuring two Danish folk songs which he recorded for Victor some time ago. His selections will include the beautiful number from the opera, "Samson and Delilah," the "May Song" in Danish, "Sailin' On," Mother's Song in Danish and the popular ballad, "In the Garden of My Heart."

Miss Elbow Mae Wilson will be heard in "Let All My Life Be Music," the song with which she won the recent Atwater Kent contest, and "Come, the Long Day is Over," her prize winning song in the state high school contest. She will also give one of her best whistling solos as a special request number.

Mr. Peckham will feature the well known bass solo, "Asleep in the Deep," which he sang in the Atwater Kent contest, the "Armorer's Song," from "Robin Hood," and other popular selections.

"Dick Posey," the beloved poet of southern Oregon, will present a new and original poem entitled, "Memories of the Farm," as well as a comedy number called "The Great Compromise" and a descriptive verse entitled "Oregon's Marble Hills."

The feature program will start at 9 o'clock, continuing until nearly 10:30, as it will be impossible to include all of the above numbers in the usual hour.

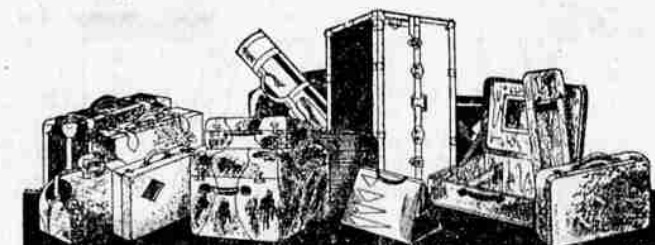
